
# What is an FSA ID & How to Create One

#### What is the FSA ID?

- The FSA ID is a username and password used by students, parents, and borrowers to:
  - o Login to U.S. Department of Education websites
  - Electronically sign documents
- You will use it:
  - o Every year you apply for federal student aid at fafsa.gov
  - o To receive a federal student loan
  - To perform important activities as a federal student loan borrower, such as choosing a repayment plan or applying for a deferment

You and your parent must have different FSA IDs.

You and your Parent must use different email addresses.





• You and your parent cannot use the same email address.

- Do not include personal info such as date of birth or your name
- If you see message "Username taken, create a different username", then that name is being used by someone else. Pick a new one.

#### **Personal Information**


 Make sure your Social Security number, date of birth, and name match EXCATLY what is on your Social Security card





# **Profile Information**

- Confirm that the information listed is correct
- If there are errors, fix them right away



## **Select/Create Challenge Questions & Answers**

If you have to reset your account because you forgot your password or username, your challenge questions will help.

Select a question from the dropdown menu and then enter your answer.

### Questions 3 & 4:

- Make up your own question and enter your answer

#### **Question 5:**


Enter an important date, such as your favorite holiday
