St. Paul Public Schools Adult Basic Education (Hubbs Center)

Hubbs Center is seeking instructors and substitute teachers for English language and reading classes for adults. Classes are taught online or in-person, daytime and evening.

Current openings:

- One teacher for low level ELL class, in person at Hubbs Center, 9:30-1:30, Monday through Thursday. Summer Session: June 20 August 17 (no school July 3 and 4).
- One teacher for Reading Lab for L1 learners with GED goals. This class is in person, 10:30-12:30, Monday through Thursday. Summer session: June 20 August 17 (no school July 3 and 4).
- Evening in person teachers for ELL classes at Hubbs Center, 5 8 pm, Monday through Thursday, starting September 5, 2023.

Minimum Qualifications: Either a valid Minnesota teaching license (ABE/ELL/related) or master's degree (ABE/ELL/related).

Rate of pay: \$30/hr. for teachers with a valid MN teaching license; \$22/hr. for teachers with a master's degree but no teaching license. Paid prep time included.

Responsibilities include:

Instruction: Use best practices in instruction for adult learners and align lessons with state curriculum standards; use a variety of instructional techniques to address diverse needs and goals of learners. Assign lessons in distance learning platforms. Find a substitute to cover the class in case of absence; prepare lesson plans for substitutes. Record attendance in ABE database.

Curriculum, planning and assessment: Design and develop supplemental materials as needed for curriculum; participate as needed in curriculum design for program, including the use of technology and distance learning platforms. Assess and evaluate student achievement according to accepted measurement criteria.
