Snap Circuit Jr. Club

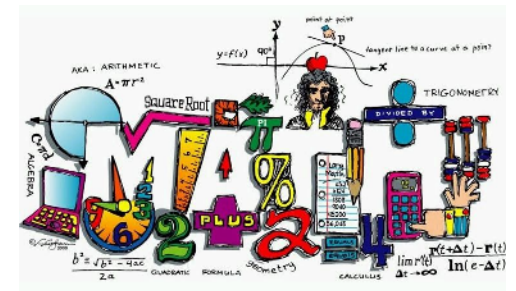
Learn about electronics, science, and engineering with mini experiments. Meets on the 2nd Wednesday, each month at 3:15. (Grades 1-5)
