Teacher of Music in the Junior School

Responsibilities include:

- Maintain a record of students' achievements and submit reports according to established procedures
- Lead and teach a Junior School choir and help prepare students to perform at various events

- Plan and teach an age appropriate, vertically aligned Music curriculum integrating the IPC Units as well as the ISH Music curriculum

Applicants must have current suitable teaching qualifications. Experience with teaching within the IPC curricular framework is advantageous. Training in current methodology in the teaching of both native-speakers and second-language learners at the Junior School level would be an asset.
