STUDENTS MUST BE 14 ½ ON OR PRIOR TO THE 1ST CLASS

For class schedule check our web site or your high school Driver Ed. webpage.

You must be at least 14 ½ years of age on the first day of the class. We assign students to classes based on age, oldest to youngest.

You should register for a class at YOUR high school OR for an alternate class such as Saturday, School Break. Do not register for a class unless you can arrive on time each day. If you want to register for a class held at a school where you do not attend, please check with the Lead Teacher to insure that outside students are allowed to attend.

Regulations for Attendance:

1. \$60 fee must be paid to register on or by the 1st day of class.
 2. Fee reduction requests must be completed prior to the 1st day of class ONLY for students who would qualify. To determine if you qualify please click on the link for Fee Reduction Request on the Driver's Education Webpage.
 3. You must be in attendance the first day. If you miss more than 4 hours of class instruction, you will be dropped from the class and will not be able to take Driver Education through the school system again.
 4. You are expected to follow the DCS behavior guidelines and comply with the driver's education teacher's rules. Failure to comply with these guidelines and rules will result in removal from the class. Any student removed for may not be allowed to take Driver Education through the school system again and no refund will be given for those students who are removed from class due to failure to attend or for disciplinary action.
 5. Students should bring pencils, paper, and a copy of your birth certificate.
 6. Students must have their own transportation to and from the school.
- **During the driver education class we will have someone come in and check the students' vision. If your student wears glasses or contacts please make sure they have them each day during class. If the examiner checks your student's vision and they do not meet the passing requirement, you will be notified in writing and they will not be able to drive until they have been seen by an optometrist and return proof to the driver education instructor.**



- **Students who feel they are ready for driver education should certainly be able to conduct themselves in a mature manner while in the classroom. They will show respect and follow rules or they will be asked to leave and try again at a later date when they can handle the mature subject. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for absences, tardiness, and inappropriate behavior!**
