The Duplin County Nursing department has been having T-DAP clinics and are now planning for flu shot clinics to be held this Fall.

Also we have been selected from Dr. Larson from ECU to be in a Latino youth pregnancy prevention grant. It will be starting next school year at BF Grady and North Duplin JR SR.

We also are having senior nursing students from ECU this semester that we are mentoring.

Sept. 23 is our 30th school day which means that all 6th graders must have their T-DAP immunizations and all kindergartens must have all their immunization and a physical or they will not be able to return to school on the 24th so we are trying to get all their information in so we can keep all kids in school

We have started this school year having 6 PRN medications in our school for the nurse to be able to give at her decision only. These meds are tylenol, motrin, cough drops, tums, triple antibiotic cream, and hydrocortisone cream. Parents will have to sign a consent letter for us to be able to give these meds. So far we have had great response to this.

We are also excited we started our school year off fully staff and all of our nurses are now nationally certified school nurses.

Duplin County Schools National Car Seat Week – Car Seat safety check point will be at Peoples Dept. Store on Sept. 12th from 2 to 5 p.m. We will have techs on site to check carseat for anyone who comes on that day.
