## PRESCHOOL EXPANSION INITIATIVE



- Pre-registration portal opens 2/1/24 @ 12:00 a.m.
- Pre-registration completed by 2/22/24 at 11:59 p.m.
- Lottery Drawing Date: 3/20/24
- Notification of acceptance and location: 4/17/24
- Reside in Edison Township.
- Birthdate on/within dates of 10/2/19 through 10/1/21.
- Successful submission of preschool lottery pre-registration. for each child with the district by 2/22/24 @ 11:59 p.m.





- Free, courtesy transportation is available for all participating preschool students.
- Busing does not include services for before/after care scheduled individually with partnering Private Licensed Child Care Centers.
- Bus routes will depend on school zones listed in the presentation (Zone I or Zone II).
- Children whose residential addresses are within geographically grouped "Home School" locations (as per the district's attendance boundaries) will attend a preschool location that also falls within the same geographical grouping, delineated as "Zone I" or "Zone II".





- Follows the Edison Township Public Schools' calendar.
- The 2024-2025 calendar will be available later this spring 2024. The current calendar is <u>available here.</u>
- Must be in session for a full day consisting of 6-6.5 hours per day.
- The school schedule is not available at this time. Information is forthcoming.

- Pre-registration will be open beginning 2/1/24 @ 12:00 a.m. via this link.
- Once a fully completed pre-registration is submitted, a notification will be sent to the contact information listed in the application.
- Inquiries regarding registration can be directed to the district's enrollment department.
  - Registration is for 3 & 4 year olds.
    - 4 Year old: Birthday on/within the dates of 10/2/19 through 10/1/20.
    - 3 Year Old: Birthday on/within the dates of 10/2/20 through 10/1/21.
- Income Eligible: Students entitled to free and reduced lunch as defined by the USDA, or directly certified through the NJ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program.
  - Include a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) benefit number or complete a free and reduced lunch application to verify eligibility.

- 2024-2025 preschool eligible siblings of 2024-2025 preschool eligible children selected by the lottery (or who are of Tier 1 status) will also be provided with a seat.
  - Pre-registration of the sibling is also required.
- Current in-district general education half-day 3 year olds will be grandfathered in; no pre-registration needed.
- Required documents for pre-registration include a parent/guardian photo ID, proof of child's date of birth (birth certificate or passport), and proof of Edison residency.



- Students identified for special education services will be serviced through in-district programs.
- Before and After Care are at the discretion and availability of the partnering Private Licensed Child Care Center.

  There is no before/after school care available in indistrict programming.



## • Tiered Approach

- Tier 1: Income Eligible 4 Year olds (~261 students).
  - Projections indicate that all students in this Tier will receive a seat. If this Tier exceeds projections,
     Students will be selected on a first come first serve basis.



- Tier 2: All other 4 Year olds & Income eligible 3 year olds (~966 students).
  - Selected via lottery drawing.
  - Selection of students for a seat from Tier 2 is contingent on seats being available after all Tier 1 students are assigned a seat; otherwise, will be drawn to determine order of waitlist.
- Tier 3: All Remaining 3 year olds (~ 705 students).
  - Selected via lottery drawing.
  - Selection of students for a seat from Tier 3 is contingent on seats being available after all Tier 1 & selected Tier 2 students are assigned a seat; otherwise will be drawn to determine order of waitlist.
- Any 3-year-old selected for a seat will be enrolled for the September 2024 and September 2025 school years.
- To secure a selected lottery seat or spot on the waitlist...
  - Accept the seat/waitlist position via Genesis Parent Portal within 72 hours upon initial notification; and
  - Complete Full Enrollment via District's Enrollment Department within 30 days of notification of available seat/waitlist position.



- Class sizes by state law cannot exceed 15 students per classroom for any Preschool Expansion Aid funded program. This requirement is also mandatory for Private Licensed Child Care Centers.
- Curricular programming and services will be consistent in Private Licensed Child Care Centers and in-district preschool programs.
- The curriculum is the state and BOE approved HighScope Curriculum.
- Potty training is not required for participation.
