- School Colors Gold and Black




At Cedarlane We Believe...

- Develop fine motor skills: holding a pencil/crayon, coloring, cutting with scissors.
- Print first name with ONLY the first letter capitalized.
- Learn to follow 2 step instructions: "Please go get your shoes and then put them on."
- Use good manners: "Please" and "Thank You."
- Talk about social skills: sharing, taking turns, positive words, talk about handling anger, resolving conflict.
- Help your child take responsibility: clean up messes, dress themselves, get their own snacks.
- Practice number recognition: Count objects daily.
- Practice letter and sound recognition: Practice saying the letters and their sounds every day.
- Build self-esteem: Praise your child often because TK/Kinder is hard!
 - LET'S PRACTICE FOR TK/KINDERGARTEN BEFORE THEY EVEN START!!!
