



Part-Time Instructor for Adults with Autism



Position

Mt. Diablo Adult Education's Adults with Disabilities program is seeking a skilled and compassionate instructor to teach adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder, and related disorders, in their transition to higher education, employment, and greater independence. Duties include: lesson planning; instruction in independent living skills, social skills, career exploration and preparation; conducting formal and informal assessments; writing student goals and assessing progress. Includes classroom and community-based instruction. Must work collaboratively with the instructional team, including planning for Senior Instructional Assistants' work with students in class. **Instruction may occur in the classroom, in the community and/or on Zoom.**

Qualifications

Applicants must have experience working with individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder and/or related disorders and have a positive and respectful teaching approach. Must possess or be eligible for the California Educational Specialist, Multiple Subject or Adult Designated Subjects: Elementary and Secondary Basic Skills, Adults with Disabilities teaching credential. *(If not in possession of an appropriate credential, eligibility for an adult education credential includes verification of at least three years of related experience and/or education in the field, a bachelor's degree, and proof of successful completion of the CBEST).*

Work Schedule

Part-time: 18 hours a week. Schedule to be determined based on program need. Program hours are 12:30pm – 4:30pm, Tuesday - Friday.
