The Young Families Program serves expectant and parenting teens and their children who reside within the boundaries of San José Unified. The program promotes school achievement for teen parents and school readiness for the children of teen parents by enhancing the social and cognitive development of all children through the provision of educational, health, nutritional, social and other services.

The Infant/Toddler Center at Broadway serves children from newborn to three years of age. Expectant and parenting students have access to a variety of support services including academic and vocational counseling, pregnancy education, health and social services, guidance and counseling throughout the year. Speak to your school nurse or attendance counselor to learn more or receive a referral to the program.
