Kat Yarbrough called the meeting to order and introductions were made at 1 pm.

- The Children's Assessment Center (Yaren Zamarripa) spoke on the Child Sex Abuse Prevention Program. The program is an advocacy center for families, which serves Harris County. Reports of child sex abuse are reported to CPS, or law enforcement, then there is a recorded interview and physical evaluation. Several trainings are available to the adults, and although this program is offered for K-12, it is mostly focused on Elementary.
- Tremayne Wickliffe, Coordinator of Student Services at LPISD, spoke about the Care (D.A.R.E.) for LPISD. Most every student has access to a smart phone in this day and time. The CARE program, and literature is available to all campuses. Social media glamorizes and caters to kids, especially when it comes to vaping.
- Discussions: A survey is needed to see about changing the SHAC meet time for futures dates, to the 1pm start time. Philip Elliot, with the Harris County Public Health, spoke on the programs available for Asthma, and resources available in Harris County. Esmeralda Ogur, also from Harris County Public Health, spoke Chronic Disease Prevention and the programs available to schools. Healthy eating, exercise, one time classes, or a curriculum is available. Paola Uranga, the last speaker for Harris County Public Health, spoke on the demographics. tool kits available, and the online classes and curriculum opportunities.
