

Homebound Instruction

The Board authorizes the use of homebound instruction when appropriate. Homebound instruction is for students enrolled in public school in St. Louis County Partner Districts and Special School District schools and accessing the public school curriculum. Eligibility for Homebound Instruction will be determined and services implemented according to Regulation IGBG-R

The amount of instruction or supportive service provided through the homebound program will be determined in relation to each student's educational needs and health.

The District will contract with Partner Districts to provide homebound instruction to non-disabled students upon request.
