

ELOISE VINING SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Purpose: To assist financially those students who have the potential and desire to further their education to achieve their personal and career goals.

Awards: Grant amounts are determined by the Screening Committee on the basis of potential of the student. The award granted will be at the sole discretion of the committee.

Eligibility: Scholastic potential
Student enrolled in or accepted at an accredited public or private college, technical, or vocational school that shows promise of ability to continue schooling.

Application Process: A completed application form must be accompanied by:

- A letter of recommendation from a school, community, or educational agency representative with a personal knowledge of the applicant's character, educational commitment, and financial needs.
- Applicant's personal essay telling about his/her background, career, and personal goals and indicating why he/she should receive this assistance.
- Proof that the student has been admitted to the school chosen.
