Tuition (included in total program cost)

Must be paid in full upon registration unless funding is provided by an agency \$995.00
 You must be 18 years of age and completed high school or equivalent to enroll in this class.
 The course is approximately 6 weeks in length consisting of 120 hours. Clinical hours are required at the end of the program. Classes are held Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Immunizations Required:

(Immunizations are not required before class beginning. Only before clinicals)

- 2-Step TB skin test must be completed and results given to the instructor (You can do this through a physician. If you are in Muskingum County, Rambo Health (740-452-5401) can do this for you as well)
- Due to clinical locations, a flu shot is recommended during flu season (typically October – March)
- Due to clinical locations, both COVID vaccinations are required before clinicals or accepted medical or religious exemptions.
