The Dream Center in the Office for Diversity and Inclusion in the Office of Undergraduate Studies works holistically with undocumented students and mixed status families from college access to graduation. The Dream Center engages in specialized advising and scholarship support for current and future University of Utah students, faculty, staff, and administration. The Dream Center also increases community wide awareness of policies affecting current and future University of Utah Undocumented students.

Non-Residents Students: Utah House Bill 144:

- The Utah State Legislature passed House Bill 144 in 2002 which allows eligible Utah high school graduates the opportunity to attend Utah's colleges and universities and have the non-resident portion of their tuition waived. A student can qualify for this waiver if they:
- Attend a Utah high school for three or more years
- Graduate or will graduate from a Utah high schools or attained the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED) in Utah
- Have not registered for college classes prior to the Fall of 2002 academic school year
- Do not hold a current visa
- Has filled or will file an application to legalize their immigration status as soon as they are eligible to do so

Non-Residents Students: Utah Senate Bill 253

As of May 12, 2015, Utah SB 253 makes it so any student who graduates form a Utah high school(regardless of high school graduation year) IS NOT required to provide proof of lawful US presence for scholarships or tuition waivers in Utah's public colleges and universities. Therefore, regardless if the student has or does not have DACA, as long as they graduated from a Utah high school, they may apply to privately funded scholarships administered by a public Utah college or university.

Non-Residents Students: Utah House Bill 118

- The House Bill 118 Tuition waiver allows eligible Utah high school graduates the opportunity to attend Utah universities and colleges and have the non-resident portion of their tuition waived. A student can qualify for this waiver if they:

The Utah States Promise is a "last Dollar" scholarship, meaning it is applied to your remaining tuition and student body fees after all other aid is applied. What is considered other aid and what order is it applied? First, Federal Pell Grant(FAFSA), and then the second USU will apply for other scholarships. After all aid and scholarships are applied USU pays the remaining balance.

Criteria-

- Be admitted as first-time incoming undergraduate
- Intend to graduate from USU
