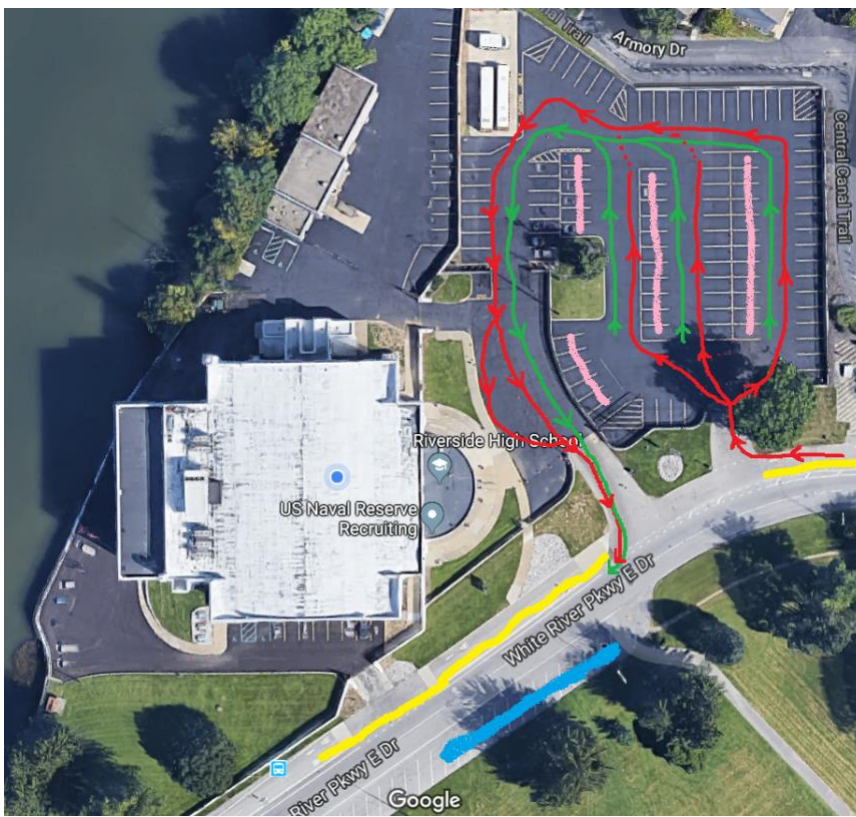


# Herron-Riverside Dismissal Pick Up Instructions

Our #1 priority when school is released at 4 pm is the SAFETY of your scholar. We have worked hard to provide you with the safest route to pick up your scholar. Using the parent pick up line (red line in picture) is the safest choice. It may take you a few minutes longer in this line, but it is well worth it to not put your scholar or other people at risk of an accident.

In order for this pick-up line to run smoothly, here are some key points:

- When turning right into the parking lot from 30th St., form three lanes as directed by the signage and indicated by red lines below.
- The three lanes will merge at the end of the parking spaces. Please alternate lanes when merging.
- Then, form one lane to turn the corner as you head back toward the school in the parking lot.
- Throughout the parking lot, a left lane should always be kept open for cars to pull-through and depart once their student has loaded. Do not pull into the furthest left lane unless you have your student and are ready to depart.
- Once you get to the black gates just before the front steps, cars should form two lanes to the right as directed by the signage, still leaving the left lane open. There will also be a staff member at the gate to assist with students crossing the pick-up lines to walk out to their cars.
- Pull all the way up in the two lanes in front of the steps of the school for your student(s) to load. Do not stop short and leave space in front of your car as you load your student.



**Red** = Parent Pick Up Line

**Green** = Path to follow to exit once you have your scholar.

**Yellow** = Danger Zone! Do not attempt to pick up scholars along 30<sup>th</sup> St. This is very dangerous as cars come flying down 30<sup>th</sup> street.

**Blue** = Parking across 30<sup>th</sup> St. Do not double park here. Use the parking spaces as intended. Students MUST use crosswalks at stoplights to cross the street and get to these parking spots.

**Pink** = parking spaces for parents to use if you don't want to idle your vehicle in the pick up line.
