Lunch, activity, and some field trip fees are included in tuition. Wooster offers several payment plans. All first payments are due July 1st. Deposits and tuition payments for the 2024-25 school year will be made online through Blackbaud Tuition Management. A **non-refundable** 10% deposit is required at the time of enrollment.

Books

Textbooks are not included in the tuition and must be purchased separately. Information about ordering options will be sent at the time of course registration.

Technology

Most student work will take place using [student laptops](#). Please note specifically the requirements for PSAT/ACT/SAT testing for grades 10-12.

Additional Note: Additional fees for bussing, college testing (PSAT, SAT, AP, ACT), athletic equipment, special events, breakage/damage, etc. will be billed on your monthly statement as incurred.

Note: Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) is required for families who do not pay the 2024-2025 tuition in full by July 1. TRP is 1.95% of the contract amount. For more information call the Business Office at 203-830-3912.

10-payment Plan Fees:

The 10-Month Payment Plan carries a 6% interest rate on the declining balance.

CT & NY Bus Service (Outside of Danbury)

There are additional fees incurred and charged to your student account when your student participates in Football, Ice Hockey, or Golf.

Estimated fees: Football \$450, Hockey \$1,000, Golf \$300. Actual fees, subject to change, may be slightly higher or lower.

Student Accident Insurance

Student Accident Insurance is available and strongly recommended. The policy covers medical and dental expenses incurred for one full year as a result of an accident. For further information, please contact the Business Office.
