

# Notes Regarding the Associate Degree Tracker

---

(1) Underlined courses have aligned college learning outcomes and high school TEKS. These courses are currently approved to be requested as dual credit through public partner schools. Not all underlined courses will be offered at every high school. Offerings are based on significant student need and credentialed HS faculty availability.

(2) Students who complete the "Course Taken: Associate of Arts (A.A.)" column obtain the Core Complete status on their LSC official transcripts. Core Complete status transfers to all Texas public institutions of higher education and ensures students do not have to take any further core courses for the sake of Core Completion. Students may still need to take core courses if they are part of their selected major. Destination institutions should be contacted for more details.

(3) PHED 1164 is required for degree completion and is not currently approved as a dual credit course. Students will be charged the college credit rate for tuition and fees. The course will satisfy 1 credit hour in the "Component Area Option" category.

(4) EDUC 1300 is required for degree completion if an associate degree is not completed before graduating high school. EDUC 1300 is not currently approved as a dual credit course. Students will be charged the college credit rate for tuition and fees. The course will satisfy 3 credit hours in the elective category, if it must be taken.

A course's number of credit hours is indicated by the second digit of the four number catalog number. Ex: MATH 1314 is 3 credit hours.

Most universities and colleges will not transfer in courses where a D was earned. Check with your institutions of interest for clarification on what to expect if you have earned a D in a class.

As you near graduation, please make an appointment to meet with the LSC Graduation Advisor in the Advising Suite for a full review of completed and needed coursework.
