

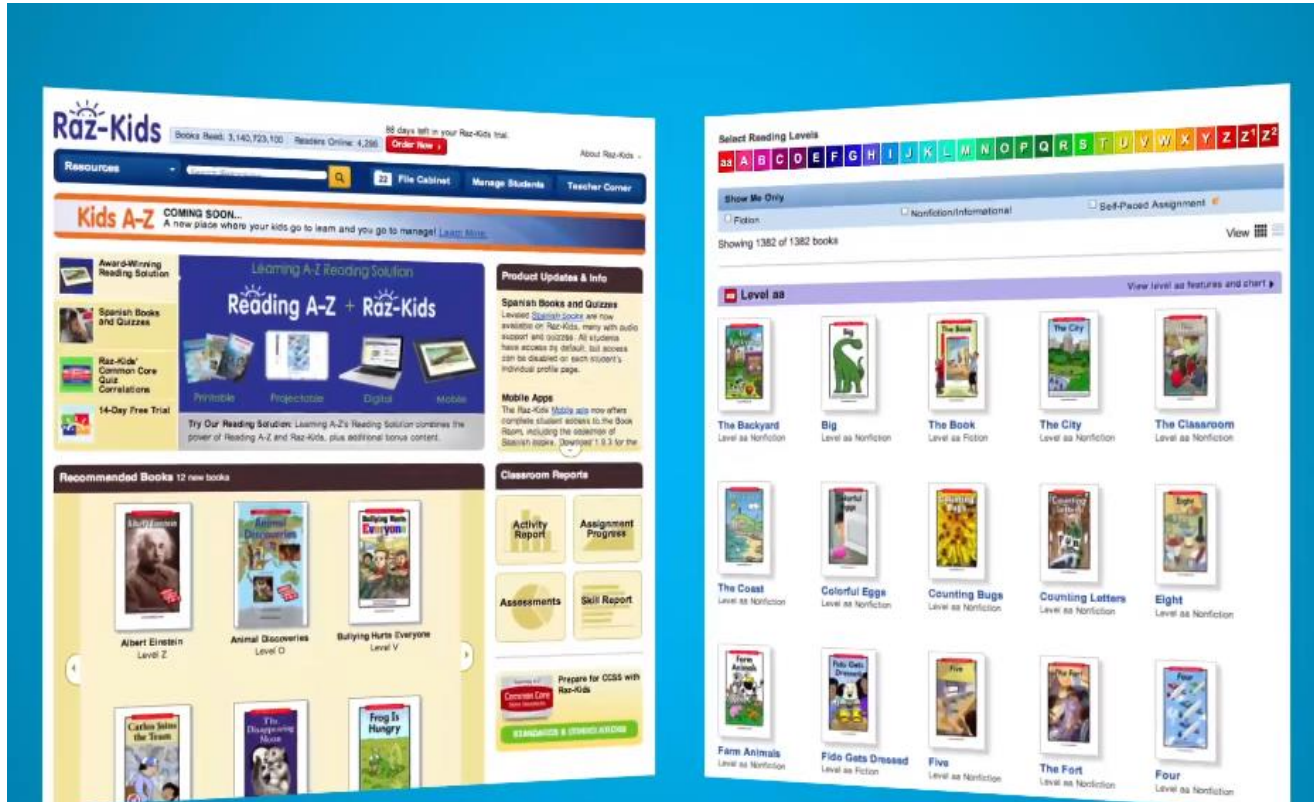

# What is Raz-Kids?

- Raz-Kids is an online resource that provides a library of differentiated books.
- Children can listen, read and take a quiz.
- Children can **practice** reading in school, at home, or on the go.
- It also supports close reading skills and the reading and writing connection with interactive tools and constructed response quiz questions.
- Make practicing reading fun plus it includes built-in motivational rewards.
  - *Recommended – reading at least 20 minutes per day*

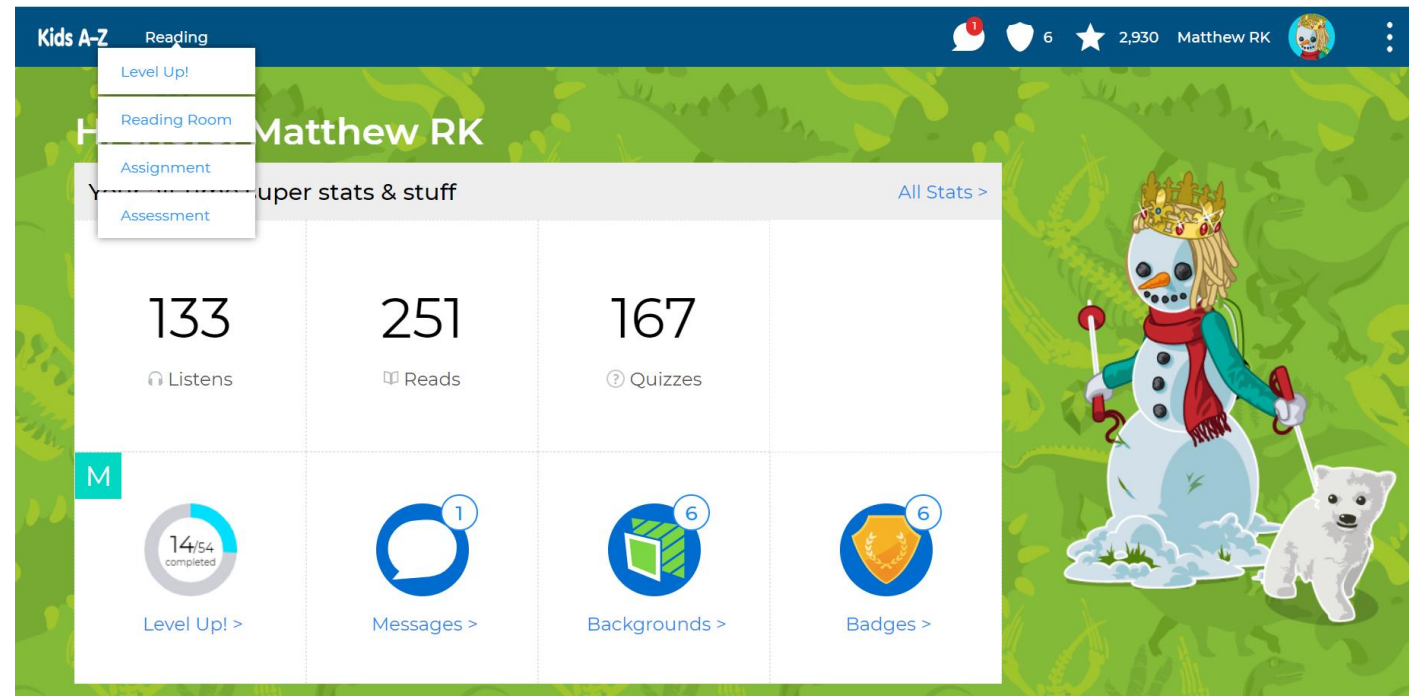


# View of Student Portal for Raz-Kids on a computer.



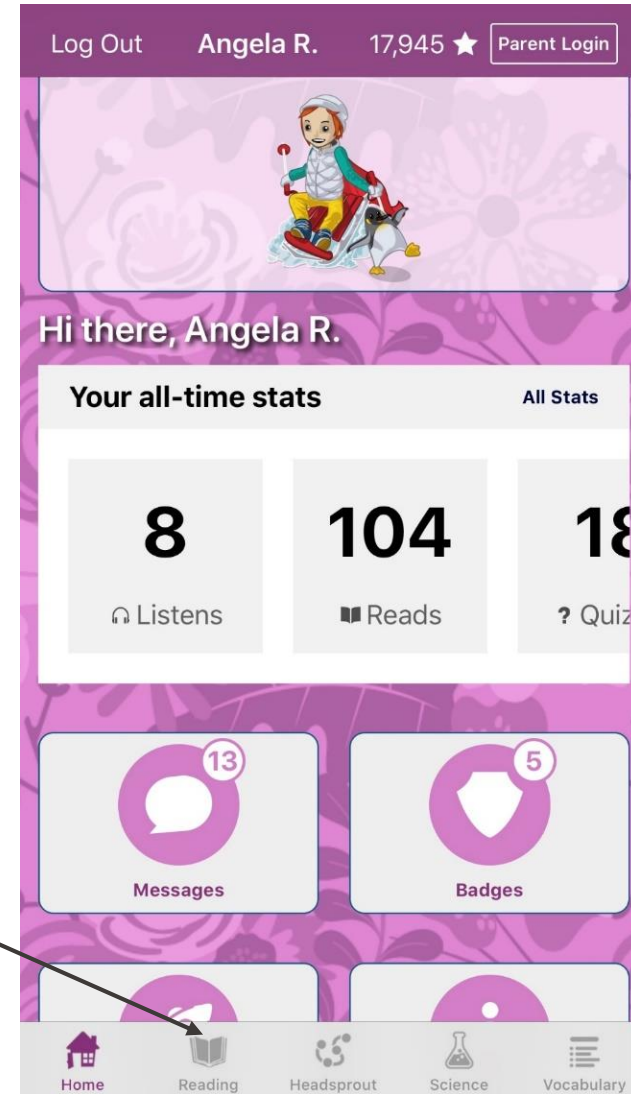
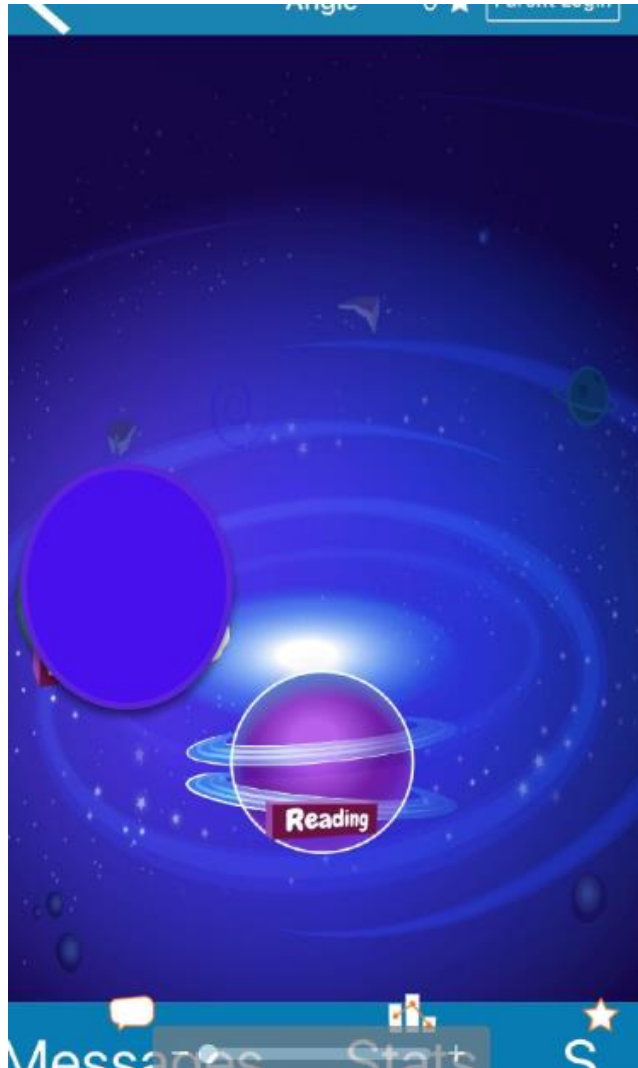
Primary Portal – Grades K-2

## Intermediate Portal – Grades 3 -6



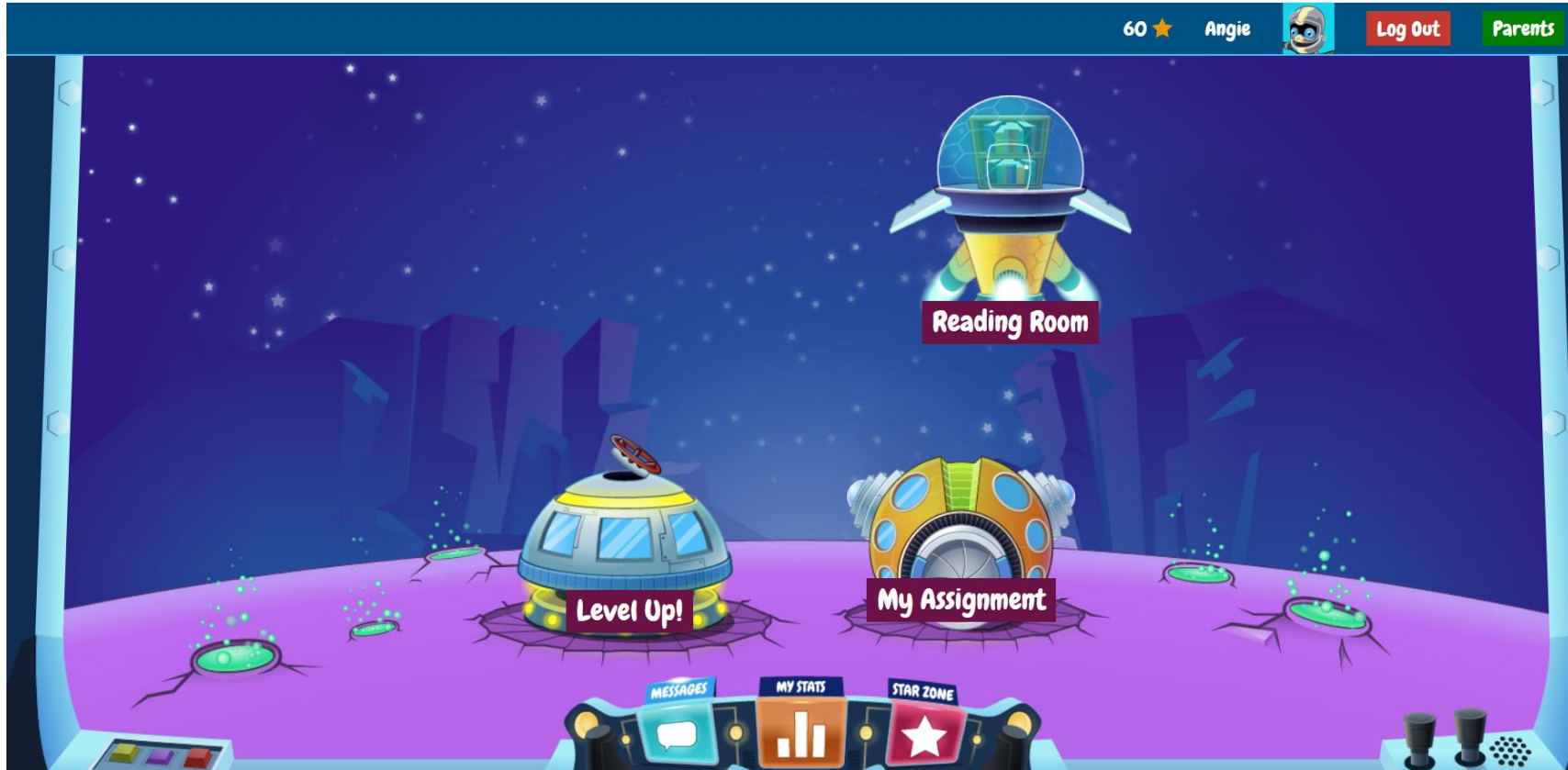



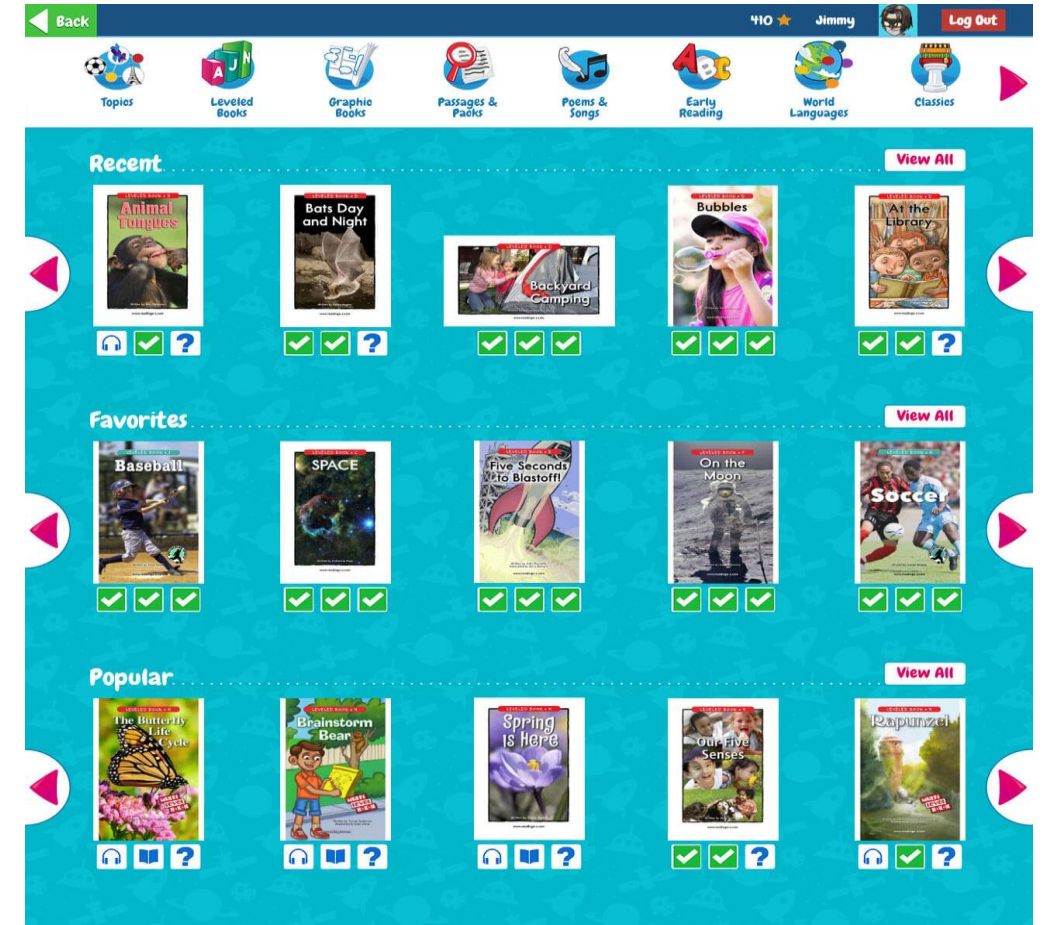
Level Up! contains a collection of books that students can complete to automatically advance to the next Learning A-Z reading level.

Students automatically Level Up! once they listen and read all the books, and pass the comprehension quizzes.

- The Reading Room makes it easy for kids to find level-appropriate books by topic, category, and popularity.
- In addition, kids can save their favorite books for easy access anytime.



# My Assignment

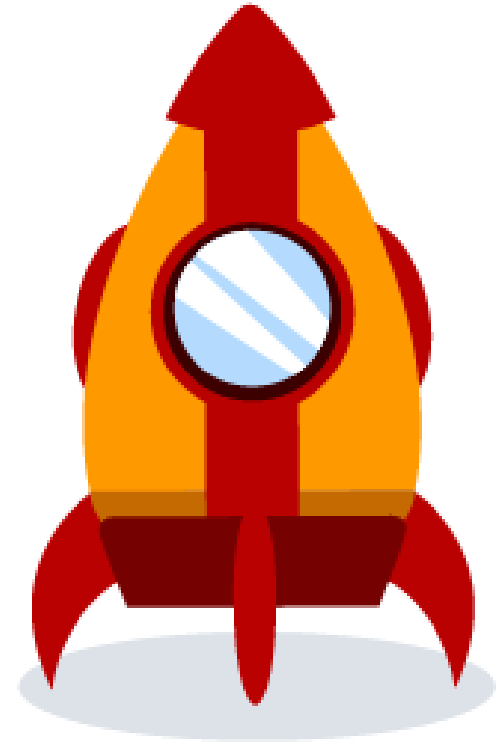
Children go to the My Assignment area to complete activities that a teacher has digitally assigned for a customized lesson.



# Student Incentives

Students earn stars for practice, completion, or success with different activities.

Stars are used to purchase fun items to personalize the Raz Rocket and to create a customized avatar using the Avatar Builder.



## Allow students to practice active reading while exploring content:

- Tools for note-taking, drawing, highlighting, and stamping make it easy for students to annotate as they read, which supports active reading practices for better comprehension
- Individual Word Audio playback reads individual words aloud to students to support phonics and fluency development in Raz-Plus, Raz-Kids, and Science A-Z
- The eJournal gives students a place to explore new words and expand or improve their vocabulary through writing.
- Vocabulary Cards provide additional information and context about key vocabulary words in a text
