The Practical Nursing Program prepares students to enter the job market in the healthcare field. Areas of instruction include basic anatomy and physiology, basic nursing skills, ethics, death and dying, medical terminology, disease process and infection control. Instruction will be provided in the classroom, the classroom laboratory and community healthcare settings. These learning experiences are conducted in a clinical and professional manner. Students will provide hands-on care to classmates in the classroom laboratory sessions in areas of personal hygiene, nutrition and ambulation. Students will be a “patient” in classroom laboratory sessions allowing other students to practice nursing skills. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner in these settings.
