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## Superintendent's Report - Board of Education Meeting - January 23, 2024 - 7:00 p.m.

**Ambitious Instruction** – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- Mid-year NWEA MAP testing is underway with growth and progress reports expected in February
- ACCESS testing has been scheduled for Jan. 29 Feb. 29 for our English Learners
- The District Instructional Music and Band Committee recommends new curricular materials for the 2024-2025 school year (Appendix A)
- The 6<sup>th</sup> grade student <u>Candor Health Presentation</u> was scheduled for 1/12 a new date will be coming soon
- GM student course selection will begin 2/9 and will include a variety of options aimed at maximizing student choice and expanding the student curriculum experience throughout middle school
- Student 'e'ttendance rates for our eLearning Days on Jan. 12th were 87% (GW) and 98% (GM) and 81% (GW) and 98% (GM) on Jan. 16<sup>th</sup> - Please give us your feedback by using our <u>eLearning Feedback Form</u> Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
  - Year to date attendance: 95.0% (93.0%) for GW (K-4); 96.1% (95.3%) for GM; 94.4% (94.8%) Teaching Staff and 94.8% (96.1%) for Student Support Staff. Previous year data
  - The Student Council's Hearts at Work fundraising efforts resulted in a \$2,572 donation to Hesed House
  - Required staff trainings (Jan. 17 for GM and Jan. 23 for GW) focused on a new state requirement "Recognizing and Responding to an Opioid Overdose" led by School Nurses
  - Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents had the opportunity to meet with Hinsdale High School District 86 guidance counselors virtually on Jan. 12th to build and review their 9th grade schedule
  - The DuPage County ROE Regional Office of Education completed the annual school inspections for both campuses and GW and GM passed with no concerns noted - A standard that we do not take for granted

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- The annual 5-Essentials Survey is set to open Jan. 23<sup>rd</sup>! We have a standing goal of 35% parent participation and encourage all of our families to help us meet it! - Last year; 52% GW, 37% GM (state avg. 19%)
- Feedback on the district's new website has been positive! Parents are encouraged to watch for a Gower School District App to accompany and streamline the online experience - Launching soon!
- Join us for our Annual STEM Night/Science Showcase on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> from 6:00-7:30 pm at GW This event is open to all families and will feature hands-on STEM activities for students in grades K-8 - RSVP here!
- Bring Your Parent to School Day is scheduled for Feb. 16<sup>th</sup> at GM and provides an opportunity for parents to experience a 'day in the life' through an abbreviated class schedule
- The Gower PTO continues to support our school community and is hosting a Winter Wonderland Family Dance at GW on 1/19 - Use this link for updated PTO News
- The Gower Foundation continues to support our school community and is sponsoring the 4th Grade Celebrating Differences Event at GW on 1/25; a popular annual event with a focus on inclusion!

**Collaborative Teachers & Staff** – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our Special Education Teams, K-8 Instructional Music/Band, Calendar Committee (virtual work), and K-4 Science had to be rescheduled.
- The Calendar Committee updated the 2024-25 calendar for Board approval to comply with Election Day as a State Holiday - Our updated calendar can be found on the district website under the Parent Tab
- Professional Learning on 1/12 was district-based and focused on Learning Progressions for general education staff and Goal Writing for special education staff - The modality was switched to virtual learning
- Each of our regular route and our sub Bus Drivers completed their annual Recertification Course (Jan. 8)
- The GEA and Board remain on-track with the Collective Bargaining Agreement timeline and met on Jan. 22<sup>nd</sup> to continue the Interest Based Bargaining Process

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The <u>High School Transition Survey</u> given annually to all D86 9<sup>th</sup> grade students and led by Gower School District is scheduled for Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> - 2023-24 is the 7<sup>th</sup> year of this area-wide survey - results forthcoming
- The administrative review process of the curriculum design, organization of instruction, current class size and bell schedule is underway for 2024-25 staffing/program recommendations expected in March/April
- The internal candidate review process is underway for the GW Asst. Principal for the 2024-25 school year -This is part of the ongoing Gower Leadership Transition Plan - A recommendation is expected in Feb.
- Gower was represented at the <u>IASB South Cook Division</u> meeting in the keynote presentation, *Born from* Crisis: An Emerging Framework for Effective Leadership, after receiving high praise from another division
