Has your family struggled to afford internet access at home during the pandemic?

THE EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM CAN HELP!

The **Emergency Broadband Benefit** is a temporary program from the FCC that provides **eligible households discounts of up to \$50 a month** for your internet bill (\$75 on qualifying Tribal lands).

Participants also get a one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer or tablet (purchased through a participating provider).

WHO QUALIFIES?

Any household with a member that:

- Has income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or participates in other government assistance programs
- Receives free or reduced school lunch or breakfast
- Received a Federal Pell Grant this year
- Lost significant income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020
- Meets low-income criteria for a COVID-19 program or a participating provider's program
