ROSSVILLE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

March 6, 2018

The School Board met March 6, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Superintendent's Office. Members present were Joe Hufford, Nathan Root, Joe Mink, Mike Emens, and Nathan McCullough. Also present were Superintendent Dr. James Hanna, Michael Gick, Tammy Melson, Marla Glover, Karla Metzler, and Mandi Pennington.

Attendees for the Spotlight portion of the meeting were Ben Underwood, Kyle Oliver, and Nolan Starkey. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Hufford, Rossville School Board President and the Spotlight was directed by Mr. Underwood. Kyle Oliver and Nolan Starkey explained the scope of *esports*. Students participating in *esports* compete against one or more players on a particular game system. Like traditional sports, players gain communication and team building skills, and are open to scholarship, STEM, job, and college opportunities.

The process of paying claims is outlined in board policy Section 805 – Payment of Vouchers. At times it is necessary to pay claims to avoid late payments charges/fees. Upon a motion from Mike Emens and a second from Nathan McCullough a resolution authorizing the Treasurer to pay claims in a timely manner to avoid late charges/fees was approved. The motion carried 5-0. (ATTACHMENT II)

Several students in the corporation require the services of a Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) as outlined in their IEP. The district has posted the position, but has not had a qualified candidate apply. Upon a recommendation from Dr. Hanna, the board approved entering a service contract with CareerStaff Unlimited who will place a licensed SLP at Rossville. The motion was entered by Nathan Root and seconded by Joe Mink. The motion passed 5-0. (ATTACHMENT III)

The motion was entered by Nathan Root and a second by Joe Mink. The motion passed 5-0.

Upon a recommendation from Dr. Hanna, Nathan McCullough entered a motion to approve Mrs. Glover presenting at FermiLab in Batavia, Illinois. Mrs. Glover will use research data in the classroom to teach and reinforce principles of Conservation of Momentum and Conservation of Mass/Energy. The motion was seconded by Mike Emens. The motion carried 5-0.

Rossville Consolidated School District was one of 54 corporations and Rossville Middle/Senior High School were one of 169 schools to receive a congratulatory announcement from the Indiana Department of Education and the Office of School Accountability & Accreditation of recognition for the Performance Qualified School Corporation program. Qualifications for this programs requires the district or school to receive a grade of an "A" the previous school year. Indiana Code outlines the instructional time requirements for schools and this recognition allows the district to exercise some flexibility around those instructional time requirements including hours and days.
