The School Board met October 1, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the Superintendent's Office. Members present were Joe Hufford, Nathan Root, Mike Emens, Nathan McCullough, and Jennifer Jacoby. Also present were Superintendent Dr. James Hanna, Chad Dennison, Mandee Nicolas, Lacy Favors, Karla Metzler, Jayden Brown, and Mandi Pennington.

A motion was entered by Nathan McCullough and seconded by Jennifer Jacoby to approve claims 14764 - 14821, the payroll dated September 20, 2019, the board meeting minutes from September 10, 2019, the minutes from the public hearing for collective bargaining on September 10, 2019, and the Executive Session from September 18, 2019.
