

**ROSSVILLE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT
PUBLIC HEARING
2019-2020 Collective Bargaining Agreement**

September 10, 2019

The School Board met September 10, 2019, at 6:45 p.m. for a public hearing with regard to the 2019-2020 Certified Personnel Contract Negotiations/Collective Bargaining, in the Superintendent's Office. Members present were Joe Hufford, Nathan Root, Mike Emens, Nathan McCullough, and Jennifer Jacoby. Also present were Superintendent Dr. James Hanna, Karla Metzler, Jason Newhouser, Sherri Johnston, and Mandi Pennington.

The meeting was recorded and went as follows:

Mr. Hufford: "Okay, I call to order the collective bargaining agreement for the Rossville Consolidated School District Board of Education."

Dr. Hanna: "In 2019, S.E.A. 390 amended the collective bargaining process to require school corporations and teacher associations to take public testimony regarding teacher compensation before starting private, formal negotiations. The Public Hearing Notice was advertised in the Frankfort Times and Carroll County Comet on August 28, 2019. Notice was also provided at the district offices and on the corporation's web site. The Rossville Consolidated School District and the Rossville Classroom Teachers Association are providing the public the opportunity to be heard concerning the negotiations of a new collective bargaining agreement between the two parties. The Board President asks that you identify yourself prior to making comments and to limit your comments to three (3) minutes and to make the address concerning the collective bargaining agreement only. This time is set aside for public testimony."

Mr. Hufford: "At this time we open up the meeting if anyone would like to address the board with public comment on the collective bargaining agreement."

Mr. Newhouse: "Good evening, my name is Jason Newhouser and I am representing the RCTA. Good evening to Dr. Hanna and members of the school board, we are really excited to serve in this process of collective bargaining so I am just here to announce that we are ready to get things rolling and get things started, and member of the community good evening to you as well. So, thank you."

Mr. Hufford: "Anyone else? Hearing none that will conclude our public comments section and our meeting will be adjourned."

Mr. Hufford: "Can I get a motion to adjourn the meeting."

Mr. McCullough: "I make a motion we adjourn the meeting."

Mr. Emens: "Second"

Mr. Hufford: "It has been properly moved and seconded to adjourn this collective bargaining agreement public hearing meeting. Is there any discussion? Hearing none, all those in favor signify by saying "Aye", opposed same sign (silence). Motion carries."
