Preschool Programs



Project Before is a dynamic learning community of early childhood learners aged 3 to 5 with unique abilities, talents, and aptitudes. Through purposeful play and meaningful instruction our programs meet both typical and special needs children where they are, and enriches them cognitively, socially, and emotionally.

All preschool classes utilize the NJ DOE endorsed *Tools of the Mind* curriculum to develop cognitive, language, and social skills, along with emerging preliteracy skills and conservation of number skills. Instruction will integrate fundamental content and skills into lessons and activities that emphasize inquiry, exploration, and play into the learning process.

All preschool classes are taught by NJDOE certified preschool teachers and a teacher's assistant, who provide a positive, nurturing environment for preschool children with and without disabilities. Preschool classes are located at several locations throughout the community and follow the Sayreville Public Schools calendar.

At all locations, Project Before preschool will be provided consistent with NJDOE requirements for high quality programming and designed to meet the NJ Preschool Teaching and Learning Standards. Administrative Oversight, Credentialed Teachers, the use of Tools of the Mind Curriculum, the use of a Master Teacher, Professional Development, Program Assessment, and Family Engagement will be consistent throughout all locations.

FULL DAY and TUITION FREE

Daily hours are 7:45 am to 1:45 pm.

Children must be Sayreville residents, and must turn three on or before September 30th.

Transportation will be provided consistent with Sayreville Public School policy.
