Registration Information

- <u>Registration</u>: Online registration opens on Monday, January 22. To register your child for an enrichment program, use our online form at <u>Barrie.org/Enrichment</u>
- <u>Payment</u>: The cost for each program will be posted to your Tuition Management Account. Payment will be auto deducted on your regularly scheduled Tuition Management payment date.
- Pick-Up: Following class, students who have not been picked up will be taken to Barrie School's Extended Day program. Please reach out to Heidi Novak at hnovak@barrie.org for students in Primary (P3, P4, P5). Space is not guaranteed. Drop in rates apply.
- Cancellation and Refunds: If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, families will receive a full refund for their students. Families who wish to remove a student from a program prior to it's start must be done at minimum three business days in advance of the start of that particular program. A partial refund, excluding a \$25 registration fee, will be returned if cancellation is three days prior to the start of that program. There are no refunds for any cancellation after a program has begun. In the event that a class is cancelled due to inclement weather, families will be given a refund for the class session missed if the class is unable to made up at a later date. There are no refunds if a class is missed due to a students absence.
