What does the levy fund?



Instruction

- Curriculum, staff training, supplies and materials
- Maintain current certificated & classified staffing levels
- Instructional technology, including student laptops and interactive instruction boards



Extra-Curricular

- Transportation and travel
- Equipment for student safety
- Junior High and High School Athletics, DECA, FFA, Knowledge Bowl, Marching Band, Middle School & Junior High Math Competitions, National Honor Society, and Pep Club



Operations

- Maintaining current custodial staffing levels
- Rising utility costs, such as fuel, heating and cooling systems



Facilities & Maintenance

- Building and grounds maintenance

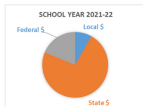

The Highland School District is asking voters to approve a 4-year Education, Programs & Operations (EPO) levy that will replace the expiring levy. The proposed EPO Levy will NOT raise tax rates and is essential to provide our students with important learning programs, classroom support and day-to-day district operations that the state does not fund.
