Prevention Practices & Social Distancing	All students and staff members will receive training COVID-19 awareness, social distancing, and proper hygiene and respiratory etiquette. CASD will practice social distancing to the extent feasible Reduce the amount of time students are in close contact with each other.	Hygiene Practices	Staff and Students are expected to adhere to hygiene practices set forth by CDC and DOH (handwashing, sanitizing, respiratory etiquette). Personal Protective equipment will be utilized by staff and students in accordance with current CDC and DOH recommendations.
Daily Wellness Checks	Prior to leaving home, students and staff members are required to take their temperatures. Anyone with a temperature of 100 Tor greater and/or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should not report to school/work and should contact his/her healthcare provider.	School Visitors	 Electronic communication is encouraged. Non essential visitors and volunteers will not be allowed to enter the school building. Essential visitors should schedule an appointment, will be required to wear a face covering and complete a COVID-19 questionnaire upon entry into the building.
Face Coverings	It is expected that all staff and students wear face coverings in accordance with the PA Department of Health (DOH)/ Governor's order(s) and in accordance with business and building safety requirements. At such time the orders are lifted, the District strongly encourages the use of face coverings unless doing so jeopardizes one's health, or social distancing can be maintained within the learning setting.	Transportation	Bus riders must wear face coverings in accordance with the PA Department of Health (DOH)/ Governor's order(s). Decreased number of students riding on buses. Students/seat and implement A/B bus runs to promote social distancing. CASD will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces. Walking to school and parent drop-off/pick-up are encouraged.
Cleaning & Disinfecting	 All cleaning supplies will meet or exceed local, state, federal, and CDC recommendations and guidelines. CASD Custodial staff use approved disinfectant and a cleaning process that ensures proper dwell time, cleaning and disinfecting of high-touch surfaces. 	Meals	CASD will implement alternate meal serving methods and utilize additional spaces to promote social distancing during breakfast and lunches. Elimination of payment terminals for students. Meal areas will be cleaned and disinfected before and after eating.
Students or Staff Showing COVID-19 Symptoms While At School	 Anyone showing signs of illness will be quarantined and sent home immediately. If a case of COVID-19 is confirmed, the DOH will provide guidance related to contact tracing, testing, quarantine, and possible school closure/ transition to online learning. Communication Plan



In an effort to increase consistency with regard to home-school communication efforts, Catasauqua Area School District will use the Remind communication tool for all levels of communication - teacher, building, and district levels. Remind provides two way communication for instructional purposes, important announcements, and urgent messages.

Technology

All students K-12 will be provided with a district owned iPad. The iPad technology fee is \$10.



Learning Management Systems

Catasauqua Area School District will employ the use of learning management systems to share instructional resources, organize assignments, boost collaboration, and establish an efficient online classroom workflow.



- Students in grades K-8 will use <u>Google Classroom</u> as their learning management system (LMS).
- Students in grades 9-12 will use <u>Canvas</u> as their learning management system.



Single Sign On



To streamline and simplify the login process for online tools and resources, the district will use <u>Clever</u>. Clever brings all K12 applications into one secure portal and provides single sign-on for everyone in the district.



Use of Diagnostic Assessments & Personalized Learning Pathways

The district will assess students' academic needs through the use of high-quality screeners for students in grades K-4 and high-quality ELA and math diagnostics in grades K through high school. The school district will utilize technology tools to create personalized learning pathways for students.
