



Sick Day Guidelines

Making the Right Call When Your Child is Sick:

Should I keep my child home or send him/her to school?

School policy (based on CDC recommendations) requires that a child **stay home if he or she:**

A child should stay home if:

- Has a fever of 100.0 degrees or higher
- Has been vomiting or has diarrhea (within 24 hours)
- Has drainage from an ear or eye (may indicate infection)
- Has a rash (until cleared by a physician)
- Is coughing or sneezing often because this spreads the sickness to others • Has symptoms that keep him/her from participating in school, such as:
 - Very tired or lack of appetite
 - Cough that he/she cannot control, sneezing often
 - Headache, body aches, earache
 - Sore throat – a little sore is OK, but a bad sore throat could be strep throat, even if there is no fever. Other signs of strep throat in children are headache and upset stomach or rash. Call your doctor if your child has these signs. A special test is needed to know if it is strep throat.
- Other contagious diseases including pertussis, ringworm, impetigo, lice, or conjunctivitis

COVID DIAGNOSIS:

- Students may return to school on Day 6 if symptoms have resolved. (The day symptoms appear is day 0)
- Students must wear a mask for days 6 -10.

24 Hour Rule:

- **Fever:** Keep your child home until his/her **FEVER has been gone without medicine for 24 hours**. Colds can be contagious for at least 48 hours. Returning to school too soon may slow recovery and make others sick.
- **VOMITING or DIARRHEA:** Keep your child home for 24 hours after the **LAST time he/she vomited or had diarrhea**.
- **Antibiotics:** Keep your child home until 24 hours after **the FIRST dose** of antibiotics for anything like an ear infections, strep throat, or pneumonia.

We often have many children and adults with colds who come to school, and they pass their sickness to others. Remember to wash hands and cover coughs and sneezes. Please help others from becoming sick by keeping your child home if he/she is sick.

Important Information concerning Emergency Closing and Dismissal due to Inclement Weather

Please read the following information for our school policy:

- Please check WFMZ for delays or closings. **ALL** districts will report the most updated information.
- Each public school district determines a closing or delay due to inclement weather. Please follow procedures for the district **YOU** reside in. If your school district is closed there will **NOT** be transportation for your child. If your school district is on a delay, your bus transportation will also be on a delay.
- In the event that the Bethlehem Area School District closes, Notre Dame of Bethlehem will close.
- Notre Dame will not close or delay based on the decision of other school districts.
- If Notre Dame is on a 2 hour delay Preschool will be on a modified schedule and Extended Care will open at 9:00am.
- Notre Dame will use FACTS communication alerts to inform our families of any delay or closing at the school.

8:30p - Post game festivities!





Pertussis Information

Pertussis is a highly contagious disease that is spread through the air when an infected person sneezes or coughs.

Symptoms:

Pertussis begins with cold symptoms and a cough which becomes much worse over 1-2 weeks. Symptoms usually include a long series of coughs (“coughing fits”) followed by a whooping noise. However, it might be absent in children, adolescents, and adults who were previously vaccinated. There is generally no fever. People with pertussis may have a series of coughs followed by vomiting, turning blue, or difficulty catching their breath. The cough is often worse at night and cough medicines usually do not help alleviate the cough. The disease can be very severe and, although deaths are rare, they do occur, especially in infants less than one year of age.

Treatment:

If there is a high chance of getting sick, the PCP can give antibiotics to lower that chance. If already ill, giving antibiotics early can help the person get well faster and lower the chances of spreading the disease to others.


