ARE YOU ON TRACK TO GRADUATE?



All alternative education students need to recover credits in order to be on-track for graduation and/or return to one of the comprehensive high schools. At Earl F. Johnson High School, students can recover credits through an online program called APEX. This program allows students to access courses that they can work on anywhere that they have access to the internet. Students will be given time during class to complete these credits, but they must work on them outside of school hours. Your student and their learning skills teacher will receive a credit recovery plan at the beginning of each semester.

STUDENT GOALS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Junior to return to comprehensive in January 160 credits required
- Junior to return to comprehensive at the beginning of Senior year 195 credits required
- IMPORTANT! If you start your senior year at an alternative education program you must stay and graduate from an alternative education program. No exceptions!
- Senior to graduate from alternative education program 220 credits and completion of the graduation requirements listed below

Ceremony Participation (walk the line) Requirements:

- 1. Attend 90% each year (Saturday school available).
- 2. Attained the required number of credits.
- 3. No debts to the school District.
- 4. No more than one out-of-school suspension for a major offense during the school year.
- 5. No time on expulsion in the senior year.
- 6. Acceptable citizenship and is eligible at the time of ceremony.
