Curriculum Updates:

11 teachers (2 from the EHS) received a two day training from EL Achieve called Constructing Meaning. EL Achieve is the curriculum used to support our English Language Learners. This is a 5 day training spread among a few months with the first two days being back to back. The purpose of this PD is for our core group of teachers to learn the strategies and bring the strategies back to PLC to teach to their team.

Constructing Meaning offers an accelerated approach to instruction that emphasizes both academic English and critical literacy skills, thereby supporting English learners in acquiring the analytical language necessary to meet the demands of content standards. It provides teachers with a clear process and practical tools for weaving explicit language instruction into content-area teaching. The focus is on teaching the content-specific language that enables students to

think, discuss, read, and write to the goals of the lesson. Even though the training specializes in English Language Learners, it will benefit all students.

New White Boards Installed

Thanks to our School Improvement grant, 23 new magnetic white boards were installed during Thanksgiving break. This was a huge upgrade which replaced the shower board that had been installed many years ago. The teachers are enjoying being able to erase their boards without a black film being left behind.
