The visit will include an overview of Conway Academy and the CSUSM co-teaching model, a student-led campus tour, classroom visits, experiencing student-led conferences, and a discussion with CSUSM teacher candidates. ## San Marcos Unified School District



Come and see how San Marcos Unified is **centering mental health as the means for improving academics**. Key to this work is collecting, analyzing, and responding to both quantitative data (e.g., Panorama survey data administered 3 times per year) and qualitative data (e.g., conducting empathy interviews with students not passing Algebra 1). In this visit, we

will share our structures and systems for mental health, including a mental health campaign and partnership with the City of San Marcos, and have a chance to hear from students on the impact of this focus. All this work is about building greater connection and sense of belonging for our students, families, and educators. (Capacity: 50 people)
