LEAD ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Parents/Guardians of 8th Graders Within Park Hill Boundaries Who Are Not Currently Enrolled in a Park Hill Middle School

Please download our 2024-25 enrollment form, fill it out, and send it back to our principal, Dr. Chris Early, at earlyc@parkhill.k12.mo.us. You can also return the form directly to our front office. Keep in mind that completion of this form does not complete the enrollment process to the district. The LEAD enrollment form lets staff know of your desire to attend LEAD in the 2024-25 school year. Enrollment to the Park Hill School District begins April 1, 2024.

The form has already been provided to your students, but you are free to download a backup copy from our site. Do not send your form directly to LEAD. Instead, have your students return their form to their counselor at their current school.

Please understand the following:

- Lead is not a traditional high school. It is based on three pillars: project-based learning, mentorship, and self-directed learning. - LEAD is a one-year commitment. Students are not allowed to transfer to their home high school mid-year.
- Selecting LEAD does not automatically guarantee admission. Admission will be granted based on space availability. In the event of a high number of requests for LEAD, we may have to look at a variety of factors, including the order in which enrollment forms are submitted. We will let you know your child's status after the enrollment window closes on February 9th.
