Notes:

1. Practical Nursing (dual enrollment) (Accelerated Career Diploma) Is under curriculum revision by the Feds and the State.
When the new curriculum is approved January/February – a detailed schedule will be added or released separately.
In the meantime, students should be scheduled full-time their 11 & 12th grade years.

2. SPCCA can add additional COFC 1080 Construction Trades Core courses (as requested by school systems). Three options for doing this includes:
