Description of SPCCA

SPCCA is a regional college and career academy that offers technical college dual enrollment certificate program training opportunities to qualifying 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students that attend Appling County High School, Bacon County High School, Jeff Davis High School, and Wayne County High School. SPCCA is currently under construction on the Baxley Coastal Pines Technical College. SPCCA opened in the 2023-2024 school year and the 2024-2025 course schedules are now available on the website. All SPCCA programs are based on industry needs assessment data in our four-county area and approved by our industry-driven SPCCA Board of Directors. Students who choose to take SPCCA programs will be provided bus transportation to and from Appling County High School on an AM or PM schedule.
