- This STEM approach partners with the District-adopted curriculum to ensure students are receiving a strong foundation in all content areas while preparing them for future opportunities in STEM.

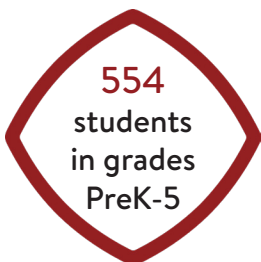

HIGHLIGHTS

- We are a Google school that utilizes Chromebooks (including a tablet version) for students to express and share their learning. Technology is embedded into the regular classroom along with a specialist class that is provided on a regular basis.
- Extended learning opportunities are available through community partnerships, field trips and school assemblies. Partner organizations include Wood Lake Nature Center and the University of Minnesota.
- A schoolwide system of support that includes English Language Learners, Newcomer Academy, Accelerated Learners and Special Education.
- After school activities include ALC (Math & Reading interventions), DELORES Works, and regionally-competitive Lego League.
- Additional STEM spaces are used to deepen student learning. These dedicated spaces include the science lab, WOW (engineering lab), outdoor garden, technology lab and media center.
