Two Rivers Night School Expectations

Parent and Student understand the following guidelines:

1. Attendance for ***all classes*** is mandatory. Students are required to attend until the course is completed and the teacher has made contact with the parent to confirm the credit has been earned.
2. Students are expected to be on-task and make adequate progress during each session. Students who fail to make progress or are disruptive will be asked to leave. A student who is asked to leave twice will be dropped from the credit recovery session.
3. Students who miss two sessions unexcused will be dropped from the course. It is the student's responsibility to make up any missing work due to an excused absence.
4. Each session will last from 4:30-6:30 PM. Students who need to catch the activity bus home at 5:20 PM must connect with their teacher on day one.
5. The course will require work to be done outside of each session. It is the student's responsibility to complete the missing work outside of class time.
6. All summative assessments must be taken during a session under the supervision of the teacher.
7. Only water bottles are allowed in the classrooms. Snacks can be eaten in the hallway during your break.
