

# How Many Do I Need to Complete?

#### Class of 2024:

- 18 Hours of Community Service
- 9 Service to School Points

#### Class of 2025 & Beyond:

- 24 Hours of Community Service
- 12 Service to School Points

#### **Examples of Approved Community Service**

- Cowlitz County Humane Society
- St. Johns Medical Center
- Longview Library
- Radical Love Meal Share



#### **Examples of Unapproved Community Service**

- Babysitting for a relative, or friend
- Yardwork or maintenance on a neighbor's home
- Any paid position



#### **Examples of Approved Service to School**

- Joining a sport, band/choir, or club
- Discipline free & no unexcused absences
- Participation in a musical or theater production
- Jack Shack



#### **Examples of Unapproved Service to School**

- Volunteering for a school in another district
- Any paid position
