Course Selection Timeline

Date	Event
January 18 (informational presentations) Friday, January 26 (make selections)	Counselors go to Wood Dale Junior High to present information on freshman year classes and students fill out a form to choose their electives.
January 18 (informational presentations) Monday, January 22 (make selections)	Counselors go to Blackhawk Middle School to present information on freshman year classes and students fill out a form to choose their electives.
February 9	Last day to make changes to initial elective class requests.

Course Selection Process

- Using the Google Form we will share with you, you will select your elective courses.
- You do not need to choose your required courses. Those will be pre-entered for you based on your current course levels and your teacher recommendations.

Freshman English courses

- English 1A & 1B or Accelerated English 1A & 1B
- Based on teacher recommendation, you may be placed into Academic Literacy 1A & 1B (this is a full-year class that will take the place of one of your electives)

Freshman Physical Education courses

- **Physiology of Exercise 9 & Health**
- If you want to open up a spot as an elective in your schedule, you can take **Health** and/or **Physical Education** during **0-hour**.
- **Class starts at 7:00 am every school day, before 1st period starts at 8:00 am.**
- There will also be a 0-hour option for students recommended for Accelerated Biology.

World Languages

- Not required for graduation from Fenton
- Many colleges require two years of the same world language for admission
- French, German, Spanish, and Spanish for Heritage Speakers (for students that speak Spanish at home)
