

Entering 11th Grade Students—2024-2025 School Year

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please read these guidelines completely as they contain important information about your student's high school course selection. It is important that you understand the course selection process, AP/Honors policy (available on the website) graduation requirements (reviewed below), and the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) eligibility requirements (reviewed below) referred to as A-G subjects. Knowing this information will help you and your student make the right choices when picking their classes.

Important Information to Consider:

- All juniors must be enrolled in six (6) classes
- Students should consult the Course Catalog (available on the website) to view course information and required prerequisites to make informed decisions about class choices. Students can also speak to teachers about class expectations.
- Students should consider their class options carefully taking into consideration not only the rigor of individual classes but the overall rigor of all of their complete schedule. Additionally, there is no guarantee that students will be able to make class changes in the future.
- **All** course selection forms must be signed by a parent / guardian. Students will not be placed in AP / Honors courses without a parent/guardian signature.
- Students earn graduation credits by earning grades of "D" or higher in their classes. For each class passed, five (5) credits will be issued per semester for a total of ten (10) credits per class per year.
- "D" grades do not meet the A-G subject requirements for UC / CSU admissions.
- Courses cannot be repeated for credit unless otherwise noted in the course catalog and on the reverse. A student can only earn a maximum of ten (10) credits per course. If a student chooses to repeat a class for which they have already earned a passing grade and credits, the previously earned credits will be removed from the student's credit total and potentially create credit deficiencies toward graduation. Students should consult with their counselor prior to repeating a course.
- Students should be mindful of the AP/Honors Policy listed on the reverse.
- Students are only allowed to select one science and one math class. Should they be interested in additional classes, they will need to enter the double math/science lottery at orientation.
- Two Years of PE is required for Graduation. Students may qualify for a PE Exemption for the second year of PE based on successful participation on school sports teams. To qualify for a PE Exemption, a student must successfully complete two seasons of a school sport and submit a PE Exemption Application. The paperwork is also available on the school website under Students-Athletics.
- **NEW:** Juniors are required to take US History. There are now 3 options to meet that requirement—US History P, AP US History, and AP African American Studies.

AP/Honors Policy

AP classes are the equivalent to college courses. Please remember that when selecting your AP/Honors courses.

By completing and signing this course selection sheet, students and guardians acknowledge the following:

- Students may only take a maximum of four AP/Honors classes during the course of one school year.
- Once students have registered for the following year's classes, they may drop any AP/Honors class up to **May 17, 2024**, with no reason or approval process necessary. Drop requests must be made in writing to the counselor by submitting a completed Course Change Request form.
- After **May 17, 2024**, all AP/Honors drop requests will be reviewed by the counselor and administrative representative. **These drops are not guaranteed, and the student may need to remain in their originally chosen class.**
- Students interested in taking more than four AP/Honors courses at one time must petition in writing (with a parent signature). You can pick up a petition in the Counseling office. Petitions must be turned in to your counselor by **February 15, 2024**, of the current school year. Students whose petitions are granted still may drop any of their AP/Honors classes up to the final drop date of **May 17, 2024**.
- Students must have submitted their completed, signed Course Selection Sheet to the Counseling Office. Otherwise, students will not be enrolled in any AP/Honors courses.

Please note that signing up for an AP/Honors class is signing on to a commitment. DO NOT sign up for an AP class if you are not sure, as we may not be able to release you from the class due to seat availability in other classes. Also note, seat availability includes the planning for new students not yet enrolled.

The following classes are the only classes which may be repeated for credit towards graduation.

Students cannot choose the order of classes. Courses offered are tentative pending student signups. Classes that do not fill may be cancelled. **Student schedules will be based on class availability and students may not receive their preference.**

How to Add a Class

1. Type in the code for the class you would like to add.

2. Select the class.

3. Click on the "Add to Plan" button

4. After you choose "add" you get this screen

5. Choose which grade level you want to take the class.

6. Choose "Year Long" for the term

Do **NOT** Choose Summer for the Term!

7. Select "Place the Course."

8. Continue adding classes until you have entered all of your selections for each grade level.

9. When you are done, **Submit** your Plan.

10. If you make a mistake or want to change a class that has been pre-populated, use the trashcan to delete the class.

You must **Submit** your plan to have your choices registered for Course Selection.

Remember, there are no guarantees. Class placement is dependent upon space availability.
