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a) Rev. Howard Johnson opened the meeting saying how much he appreciates the Association and the work they do for their members. He encouraged all present to be respectful and professional during discussions and that his personal goal is for Roseburg Public Schools to be the district that other districts call to see how we do things. Introductions then happened.

II. Commons Agreements/Collective Processes/Ground Rules

- a) Jared Cordon, Superintendent, facilitated discussions around the process moving forward and setting ground rules. No specific list of rules were set but the collective agreed the discussions should be open, honest, and professional. It was also determined that the meetings will be closed to the public but additional Association members will be allowed to be present in the room but not at the table. They can take notes and relay comments to the Association during caucusing but they are not able to participate during the meetings. Association members should contact Amanda Sandoval to attend bargaining sessions.
 - i) These additional Association members are allowed to be present at the meetings after work hours. If they wish to attend during work hours, they should use personal leave.
- b) The official minutes will be taken by the District. At the start of each meeting, the minutes from the previous meeting will be submitted for approval by both sides. If there is a long time between two meetings, the minutes will be submitted for approval via email. Audio recordings of the meetings will be taken for note-taking purposes only.
- c) The District agreed to give their counterproposal to the Association no later than end of day on Wednesday, January 17th. Both parties agreed that a response from the District would be appreciated earlier and the District will endeavor to do so, if possible.

III. Presentation on District Finances followed by Discussion

a) Cheryl Northam, our Director of Finances, gave a financial presentation that discussed funding sources, how funding can be spent, and what an 'ending fund balance' means. Time was allowed for discussion and clarifying questions. See attachment for presentation handout.

a) Bob Sconce, OEA Uniserv Consultant, presented the Association's proposal with explanations for each request. Clarifying questions were asked as the items were presented. Both parties went into caucus following the presentation.
