BUILDING FUTURE LEADERS

CCAs prepare students for the future with a wide range of skills that are transferable to any career path. Our West Lake MUN program nurtures public speaking, collaboration, and creative problem-solving skills. This can help students go on to careers in advocacy, social justice, and international law. Similarly, our athletic CCAs can ignite a passion and pathway into a professional sporting career. HIS is proud to be part of a larger network of associations including HISAC, SISAC, and ACAMIS to allow students opportunities in other cities and countries. Throughout the school year, students start at domestic competitions, leading up to international tournaments building confidence and skills along the way.

IMPACT ON ACADEMIC RESULTS

Our IB results show a positive correlation between CCAs and high academic grades. In the last five years, the top scoring IB student has always been a single or multiple sport athlete, with final scores ranging from 42-44. In addition, faculty overall report low incidence of behavior issues, a testament to our holistic approach to learning on positive behavior and community spirit.

BOOK-TO-FILM CLUB

Grades 6-12

The process reflects the unity of form and spirit, and the tea art formed during the tea drinking process mainly includes a series of contents such as

YOUGO SPORTS - FLAG FOOTBALL

Kindergarten-Grade 7

Introduce your child to the fun and excitement of flag football. Flag Football is a safe and childfriendly version of tackle American Football where you pull off the flag of the ball carrier instead of tackling. Flag Football is a fast game which requires agility, a good sense of balance, and athleticism. This activity is conducted by the experienced coaches of Yougo Sports. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS and all payments are made directly to the CCA provider. K-Grade 3, 60 minute length. Cost is 180RMB per session. Grades 3-6, 90 minute length. Cost is 200RMB per session. There may also be additional costs for purchase of uniforms and equipment for participants.

TAEKWONDO

Kindergarten-Grade 12

Introduce your child to the ancient art of Taekwondo. This activity is suitable to all ability levels and ages. Students will be guided by qualified intructors and learn the skills, movements, and disciplines associated with Taekwondo. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS and all payments are made directly to the CCA provider. Cost for each 60-minute session is 120RMB.

BASKETBALL

Grades 3-5

This CCA introduces students to one of the most popular sports in China and the world: basketball. Participants will learn and develop all the fundamental skills of the sport through fun, non-competitive activities. This is great preparation for students who may wish to join our teams when they enter Middle School.





KICKBALL

Grades 3-5

Kickball (also known as soccer baseball in Canada and football rounders in the UK) was invented in the United States. Youth kickball is a great way for kids to build social skills, develop teamwork and an active lifestyle. The game combining elements of baseball and soccer, in which a soccer ball (soft ball) is thrown to a person who kicks it and proceeds to run the bases. Sports fundamentals like kicking, throwing, and catching are learned and practiced while having fun. Kickball has all of the strategy of baseball without the difficulty and hazard risk.

REBOUNDING TRAMPOLINES

Grades 1-5

Rebounding is a fun, low impact exercise that is done on a small trampoline using music. It is a excellent way to encourage children to be active and learn to have a healthy lifestyle. Studies have shown that rebounding has the following benefits:

- bilateral motor skills develop (as both sides are used at the same time)
- co-ordination, spacial awareness and balance will improve
- better muscle control and building a strong core and bones
- rhythm improves as children follow music while exercising

Rebounders and accessories will be provided but students should bring a water bottle, towel and clothes to exercise in. We will rebound without shoes.

FOOTBALL (SOCCER)

Grades 3-5

A fun, non-competitive activity which will introduce participants to the core skills of football and allow them to develop skills, friendships, and confidence. This is a great activity for those looking to join our HIS football teams when they reach Middle School.

TOUCH RUGBY

Grades 3-4

Come and learn the skills of this inclusive and fast-paced sport, introduced through safe and active practice activities. Students will develop their coordination, communication, and social skills. This is excellent preparation for students interested in joining our Middle School Touch Rugby team in future years.

AERIAL DANCE AND HOOP Grades 3-6

Have you ever seen the Cirque du Soleil? Do you want to learn how to fly? In this CCA you will be learning about how to do aerial dancing with large fabrics and a hoop. You will build strength, and flexibility while learning this beautiful dance practice.

BRAZILIAN JIUJITSU

Grades 5-12

Brazilian Jiujitsu (BJJ) is a self defence martial art that focuses on ground control and submission techniques. Participants will develop their physical attributes including balance, agility, strength and coordination. It is the fastest growing martial art in the last 30 years because of the growing popularity of mixed martial arts. The Hangzhou Asian Games saw Jiujitsu exponents competing for the very first time. Our instructor, Mr. Suresh, is a purple belt from the Checkmat Association, one of the top 3 international BJJ teams.

CRICKET

Grades 4-11

Cricket has it all! Throwing, Catching, Batting, Bowling, Running and more. In this CCA we will learn and practice the core skills of cricket using fun games and activities and then use them with weekly mini games in our CCA group. All ability levels are welcome!

GOLF

Grades I-12

Want to learn how to play Golf? There are classes each afternoon from Monday to Friday. Classes are split into 2 ability levels - Beginners and Advanced. This CCA is delivered by accredited coaches from JG Golf Academy who are certified by the China Golf Association. Students will learn all of the skills/shots used in Golf. All equipment is provided. Students will practice at a purpose-built golf training area at HIS. Each coach will assist a maximum of 6 students. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS and all payments are made directly to the CCA provider. Cost for each 60-minute session is 260RMB for Beginners lessons, 350RMB for Advanced.

ROWING CLUB

Grades 4-12

Rowing is a team sport practiced in high-tech boats. It develops coordination and whole body physical strength. This CCA is provided by a local training centre and offers highlevel coaching for participants of all ages and ability levels. The coaches are all accredited and include former Chinese national team representatives. Students who join in this CCA will be transported to the training centre on Xianghu Lake by HIS and parents will then need to arrange collection of their child from the training centre at the completion of each activity. There is a minimum height requirement for this activity due to the size of the boat - all participants must be at least 135cm tall. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS and all payments are made directly to the CCA provider. The cost for one 10-week CCA is 6800RMB. Students who join at the beginning of the year can pay a total of 16800RMB for the full-year.

TABLE TENNIS

Grades 2-12

This CCA offers students the opportunity to recieve small group coaching from qualified coaches. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS. All ability levels are welcome to join. Coaches are predominantly Manadarin speakers. 1:4 classes are 2800RMB for 10 lessons, 1:2 classes are 4800RMB for 10 lessons.

ATHLETE PREPARATION PROGRAM (APP) / PHYSICAL CONDITIONING FOR TEENAGERS

Grades 8-12

This activity is for those who want to learn about how to effectively and safely use free-weights and fitness equipment to improve their physical conditioning and well-being. Students will learn and practice correct techniques in order get the most from their training and reduce the risk of injury. This CCA is a must for all student-athletes wanting to perform at the best!

NATURE WALKS AND HIKES

Grades 6-12

This CCA invites students to explore the natural beauty surrounding our school grounds. Students will engage in gentle hikes, observing local flora and fauna, and learning about ecosystems. This activity aims to foster a deeper connection with nature, promote physical well-being, and deepen an appreciation for environmental stewardship. Join us as we step into the great outdoors, fostering a sense of curiosity and mindfulness in a neutral and inclusive environment.





Life Skills

MINI CHEFS

Kindergarten- Grade 4

Our Mini Chefs will learn the basics of cooking and make their own cookbook. They will be encouraged to make things independently and build their confidence in the kitchen. The class will consist of being safe in the kitchen, cooking/baking, and creating their own mini cookbook. Fun, simple recipes that are achievable and easy to follow. A fun and creative cooking experience!

POWERUP GIRLS FOR LIFE Grades 4-5

In this CCA, girls from grade 4 and 5 will learn practical tools for building self-esteem and confidence without entitlement, positive body image, safe social media use, ways of coping with stress, empathy and assertiveness, problem and conflict solving, and much, much more using the PowerUP Girls for Life curriculum. We will be a supportive group where girls get to cultivate community, have fun, build friendships, and build self-esteem to last them their whole lives through. We will have guest speakers and engaging activities in a safe space for all participants.

SPECTACULAR SPAN GROUP!

Grades 4-8

Have you ever been a new student? Do you remember what it feels like to join a new school or have to make new friends? Do you want to be an important leader in our HIS school community? Are you a student in Grade 4-Grade 8? Well then, this is the CCA for you! The Safe Passages and Networks (SPAN) Committee is excited to offer this new CCA to serve our HIS community in meaningful ways, such as hosting meet-ups, helping new families adjust to life at HIS, and supporting students who will move on to new adventures around the world. In this CCA you will plan fun games, events, and outreach programs to make our community at HIS even more amazing.

TIME MANAGEMENT SKILLS FOR STUDENTS

Grades 4-8

This CCA will introduce a new concept about using right tools to help organize your time no matter if it is for schoolwork, sport events, free times. There are two systems for junior

and senior students based on the age level. The organizers will introduce students to different methods that best suit their needs.

HIS COMMUNITY GARDENERS Grades 1-9

Students will gain an appreciation of the outdoors and how food is grown in the community garden. Students will prepare the soil plant seedlings and seeds and harvest the plants. Students will learn about the nutrients plants need and how best to deliver these nutrients. Older students may choose to work with hydroponics or help younger students work in the garden.

BAKING CLUB

Grades 8-12

The best thing about this CCA is that you get to eat all the delicious food that you bake each week! Come and practice your cooking skills by making some baked delights each week in a small group setting.

INTERNATIONAL AWARD (DUKE OF EDINBURGH)

Grades 9-12

HIS is proud to offer the prestigious Duke of Edinburgh (DofE) International Award, a program that equips students over the age of 14 with invaluable skills to assist in their future academic and professional careers. Students can complete 6 months (Bronze), 9 months (Silver), or 12 months (Gold) worth of activities that include physical recreation, helping younger children in elementary, volunteering with charities, and supporting our local Hangzhou community. During the fortnightly meetings, they will also learn camp craft, first aid, and navigational skills ready for our practice expedition. A fee of 910RMB is required from each participating student. Additional fees are then required for ouradventurous journeys and expeditions.






Design and Technology

INTERNATIONAL LIFEGUARD TRAINING PROGRAM

Grades 10-12

The International Lifeguard Training Program (ILTP) is an internationally renowned, handson lifeguard course that is highly interactive and physically enduring. ILTP is designed and intended to be delivered as part of an integrated curriculum that includes water rescue techniques, First Aid, Health Care Provider CPR, Emergency Oxygen Support, and Automated External Defibrillation as a first responder. Students will participate in lifeguarding roles throughout the class and are expected to perform lifeguard duties as first responders. Students will perform on deck and in water simulations, drills and exercises for rescue techniques as an individual and in team scenarios as part of multiple rescuers drills. Students who successfully complete the course obtain an ILTP certificate that is valid for one (I) year. Annual renewal is required. PRE-REQUISITES: Participants enrolling in this CCA must be at least 15 years or 16 years of age dependant upon certificate desired, and be competent swimmers.



DESIGN AND BUILD

Kindergarten-Grade 2

In this CCA, students will have the opportunity to design and build using their imagination. They will have access to a variety of building materials (legos, manga tiles, and blocks). Each week, they will have a different prompt and will first create a design before building. Through this CCA students have the ability to learn about the design process and work collaboratively with their peers to create and build with one another.

CODING CLUB

Grades 4-5

Students will learn the essential computer algorithms using a powerful but intuitive coding system called Blockley. This system allows students to master advanced programming concepts without the high overhead of learning the grammar of formal computer languages. Students will work at their own pace and receive one on one tutelage when needed from the instructor. Many students take the CCA two or 3 times and pick up where they left off in the last session. Many have become very competent programmers ready for the next steps in Computer Science and Robotics.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

Grades 3-6

Unleash your imagination and learn how to frame breathtaking shots, using iPads, that make the ordinary things around us seem extraordinary! The Digital Photography CCA will take you on a journey of light, angles and creative expression, and we will learn some of the 'tricks' photographers use to bring subjects to life. We will view, and discuss great photography, then experiment with capturing some awesome snapshot moments. Then, we'll work on editing in order to make those moments you have captured pixel-perfect. So, zoom into digital photography and exhibit your 'lensational' talent!

SNAP CIRCUIT ELECTRONICS Grades 2-3

Snap Circuits teaches basic engineering, electronics and circuitry concepts by building components with snaps to assemble electronic cicuits. The resulting projects function like the printed circuit board found in most electronic products. This activity leads into Grade 4/5 Coding CCA and our Upper School Robotics programmes.

AIRCRAFTS AND AVIATION

Grades 3-6 (Beginner Level) Grades 3-7 (Advanced level)

The Chinese aviation/aerospace industry will need millions of employees within 15-20 years. This course is designed to help students interested in aviation or aircrafts to take that first step on the road towards becoming pilot or working in aviation/aerospace field by introducing them to the science, uses, and operation of aircrafts. Now is the time to prepare children for a bright professional future. Go further into the World of Aviation, continuing on from the basic level to learn more about the science and engineering of airplanes, what to do in an emergency, and how airports are designed. Make your own Lunar rover while learning about astronautics, the journey into Space, and other hands-on projects. These classes will be 75 minutes in duration. This activity is provided by a private company endorsed by HIS and all payments are made directly to the CCA provider. The cost for CCAI is 4400RMB (400RMB per lesson).

ROBOTICS CLUB - MIDDLE SCHOOL Grades 6-8

Come and learn how to design, build and then use VEX Robotics systems. Use coding, problemsolving and creativity to use robots to compete in various challenging games.

Games



ONLINE DRAWING AND VECTOR GRAPHIC DESIGN

Grades 6-10

This CCA focuses on learning how to use the online drawing and designing tool Figma. Students will learn how to create different shapes and lines with the website and how to use them to draw a full picture. Students can then apply these skills in drawing as a hobby, designing webpages, constructing diagrams, sketching for design projects, and many more.

HIS VARSITY ROBOTICS TEAM Grades 9-12

This year HIS will form it's first Varsity Robotics Team which is open to High School students and practicing throughout the year to prepare for competitions against students from various international schools in China in September, December, February and March. Students will meet once a week as a group but will also be able to access the Robotics Room any day of the week to further develop their skills with the VEX Robotics System. Please Note: Students who register for this in CCA1 would be expected to continue in CCA2 and CCA3.

TRADITIONAL CHINESE FOLK GAMES

Kindergarten, Grade I

In Traditional Chinese Folk Games we will gather together to explore interesting traditional games such as: Old Wolf Old Wolf What Time Is It, Dropping Handkerchiefs, 123 Wooden Man, Jumping Houses, Eagle Catches Chick, Tug of War, Blind Man's Buff, Many Little Fish Came Here, and more. Since these folk games involve tongue twisters, nursery rhymes, there will be a lot of Chinese integrated in the activities.

CHESS CLUB

Grades 3-12

Come to practice and play Chess with other students from a variety of grade levels. Any level or rank is welcome to join. Emphasis is on participation and fun! There will be a possibility for a competitive student experience.

TABLE TOP GAMING

Grades 3-12

Table Top Gaming is for anyone who enjoys Board Games, Card Games, Dice Games or Role Playing Games. We will have a variety of options for students of different ages and interests. Tabletop games is an opportunity to not only develop critical thinking skills through systems navigation, but also social skills through competitive and cooperative peer interaction.

DUNGEONS AND DRAGONS

Grades 6-12

Students will play Dungeons & Dragons together in campaigns of 5-6 students each. Some students will be Dungeon Masters (DM's) and they will need to create campaigns and plan activities for each CCA.



Art and Creativity

ARTS AND CRAFTS Kindergarten-Grade 2

In this CCA, students will have lots of fun making some crafts and doing paintings in the class. We look forward to seeing all the children who love to be creative join us for arts and crafts!

CREATIVE LIGHT CLAY Kindergarten - Grade 3

The meaning of handcrafting lies in experiencing the joy of creating with your own two hands. In creative clay classes, children can use ultra-light clay to make all kinds of interesting and delicate items - an exquisite necklace, tempting donuts, or a colorful animal world. Children experience the fun of light clay crafts through hands-on practice and operation.

KNOT JUST BEADS Kindergarten-Grade 5

Explore your creative talents while you develop your fine motor skills and make new friends as we create beautiful things with different beads and goodies.

MANDALA CREATIONS Kindergarten-Grade 2

Mandala is traditionally created as a form of art using a variety of shapes, colors and symbols. It is a spiritual and ritual symbol in Hindu and Buddhist cultures representing the universe. The use of Mandalas has many benefits, including helping to reduce stress, improve concentration, and promote emotional healing. Mandalas can help build inner peace and balance, aiding in the development of spiritual awareness and understanding.

PAPER FOLDING, ORIGAMI, PAPER CRAFTS

Kindergarten- Grade 2

This CCA will have students folding and tearing

paper to make the most exciting crafts. From science to math and history, students will craft their way to making animals, buildings and so much more.

BEADING FUN Grades 4-5

A class of creativity through craft activities using small beads. You will be able to use your imagination to make fun pictures through different patterns and designs,.

CHINESE TRADITIONAL HANDCRAFT - CLOISONNÉ Grade 2-5

Cloisonné is also called copper padding thread enamel. Students first stick the copper wire onto a pattern on a bottom plate and then fill the colored sand into the pattern. Finally, after the sand has dried, put protective glue on it and the work is completed.

DRAWING 101 Grades 1-2

In this "how to draw" CCA, children will have step-by-step instructions to draw various things. The children will have access to multiple writing tools and art materials to add to their drawings each week. This is targeted at children who love drawing but are at the beginning stages.

MOVIE CINEMA EXPLORATION Grades 3-5

Do you enjoy watching films? Come discover films from around the world. We will inquire on how different films impact our community. We will identify the setting, plot, characters, theme, moral, etc. Can you be a critic? Inquire on what lesson the director is trying to teach the audience. What can we learn from films?

SCRAPBOOK DECORATION Grades 3-5

We will create different themed scrapbooks. Leave beautiful memories for your school life or vacation time. Meanwhile we will deepen our understanding on "How we organize ourselves" and enjoy art and life in the process of creating handmade scrapbooks.

DRAWING AND SKETCHING Grades 3-9

To improve the level of hand-drawn design, systematic practice and mastering the characteristics of lines are essential. To draw the beauty of lines, we will do a lot of practice, including fast lines, slow lines, straight lines, broken lines, arcs, circles, continuous lines, etc. This CCA aims to foster creativity, observation skills, and attention to detail as students gain mastery over lines.

KNITTING AND CROCHET Grades 2-10

Students will learn the fundamentals of knitting or crochet, depending on their preference. Beginners can work on basic pieces such as

dishclothes and work toward more advanced pieces like hats or scarves as their skills progress. Students will develop their fine motor skills and ability to follow patterns and instructions as they learn these amazing traditional arts. Knitting and crochet are also proven activities to decrease stress and practice mindfulness. No previous experience is required!

ORIGAMI AND 3D PAPER FIGURES Grades 6-8

Origami has many benefits for our students. It helps to develop hand-eye coordination, sequencing skills, attention skills, patience, temporal spatial skills and problem solving abilities. It is also a great stress reliever!

CERAMICS Grades 6-11

A ceramics-pottery class for students who are interested in learning and developing their knowledge and skills in clay. Students will be introduced to all basic aspects of sculptural pottery and develop their understanding of the procedures of working with clay and different techniques and tools for building.

FILMMAKING CLUB Grades 6-12

The Filmmaking CCA is a way for students to get creative and explore their interests in the medium of film. This activity involves students learning the basics of filmmaking, such as storyboarding, cinematography, and basic editing. Students work in small groups to create short films, documentaries, or even animated stories. Students will gain valuable hands-on experience in filmmaking, increase their problem solving skills, and gain confidence in their own creative abilities.

Each student will need a phone with a camera for this CCA.

Students will learn the basics of podcast creation. From creating scripts, finding a niche and analyzing existing podcasts, students will learn how to create a form of modern day broadcasting. Students will learn how to record content and use sound editing tools on their computers in order to create an effective podcast. Students will also practice doing research and interviews when

MINI SCIENTISTS Grades 2-3

Students will conduct experiments through the Scientific Method (ask a question, form a hypothesis, experiment, collect data and reach a conclusion). These are hands on experiments that will excite your child, bring curiosity into their minds, and inspire them to be scientists. They will test 2 or more items for each hands on experiment. This CCA covers a variety of sciences and is suitable for any level of knowledge.

JUNIOR SCIENTISTS Grades 3-5

Students will have the opportunity to learn science and the scientific process through fun, hands-on tasks. Our aim is to spark their curiosity and inspire an interest in science. Each CCA will feature experiments and practical tasks for children to take part in. Students attending the CCA do not need to bring any special equipment, only an interest in the subject. This CCA aims to cover different aspects and branches of science and is suitable for children with any level of scientific understanding.

GIN CLUB

Grades 6-12

The GIN Club focuses their efforts on environmental education and undertakes projects to promote recycling awareness, composting and waste management. All GIN members should have some existing leadership qualities and must have an interest in researching global issues, finding measures to improve environmental education, solving



positive contributions in HIS, and to reach their own personal IB goals. The GIN Club will be collaborating with Grade II Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS) and MUN, with emphasis on the sustainable development goals of the United Nations.

MODEL UNITED NATIONS (MUN) Grades 6-12

Hundreds of thousands of students worldwide participate every year in MUN at all educational levels – from primary school to university. Many of today's leaders in law, government, business and the arts participated in MUN as students. Students who join this CCA will be expected to participate in West Lake MUN Summit which HIS will host and also be given the opportunity to join in other MUN conferences held throughout China and overseas during the year.

PSYCHOLOGY CLUB

Grades 8-12

Psychology club provides students opportunities to acquire knowledge and enjoy interesting activities related to psychology. It works to explore human nature in depth, discuss the development of modern psychology, and the impacts of mental disorders on teenagers. The students will give insight into fun psychological topics, including personality, mental problems, personal identity or relationships. Furthermore, the club members will work together to conduct meaningful investigations, experiments or exhibitions for the purpose of creating a warmer and healthier study environment for students.
