Parents and Guardians of Johnson High School Juniors:

On Tuesday, April 19th, students in 11th grade will be offered an opportunity to take the ACT Plus Writing Test at Johnson High School. Students must arrive for test check-ins at 7: 35 a.m. and testing will start at 8:00 a.m. Students arriving late will not be allowed to test. The ACT test is required for admission to most four-year colleges and universities.

Students who have signed up must participate in the ACT pre-registration, which will be held after school, starting at 3:15p.m., on Thursday, March 30th and Friday, March 31st in the auditorium. **Students must attend one of these two sessions. Students who do not attend the pre-registration will not be allowed to test on April 19th.** Please indicate on the form below which session your child will be attending.

There are a few short breaks scheduled during the exam, but for the most part, students will be testing from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. **Students are responsible for making up missed assignments.** After the test, students will eat lunch and they will have the option to leave school. Parents are responsible for their student once they leave the school building.

The April 19th ACT test is free to all SPPS juniors who sign-up. Students interested in taking the April 19th ACT test should either 1) Pick up and complete a registration form in the CCRC, room 1017, or 2) Fill out the form below and return it to the CCRC. All interested students must sign up by Friday, March 17th.

There are varieties of ways to prepare for and increase students' scores on the ACT. Several free preparation options are still available to SPPS students, including the 3-hour Princeton Review and the ACT prep course on Naviance. The ACT website (www.actstudent.org) also has sample questions and tips for success.

Students should get plenty of sleep and eat a well-balanced breakfast. Students need to bring a calculator, two sharpened #2 pencils, and their school ID or other form of photo ID in order to take the test.
