Motion to Approve the 14 November 2023 Minutes:

Mr. Brent Bogart moved to approve the 14 November 2023 minutes; COL Ben Knisely seconded the motion and the board unanimously approved.

Head of Middle School Report: SMA-COL Tom Vara provided a read-ahead report. He discussed successful outreach with enrollment presentations to area elementary schools as

well as finalizing second semester admissions. SMA-COL Vara stated data would be provided at the next board meeting for the PM2 results.

Head of High School/Provost Report: SMA-COL Christina Bowman provided a read-ahead report. She introduced cadet senior Jack Gutauskas who discussed the Flag Retirement Ceremony on 30 January at 5pm for their Service Learning Project for JROTC accreditation.

Chair McElheny stated to amend the agenda for Vice Chair Erica Gregory to present after the Head of High School report. SMA-COL Bowman discussed the school grade increasing to a "B" and commended Dr. Cecilia Ferradino and SMA-CPT Makayla Francis for directly responsible for increasing ELA points and reading literacy. She mentioned that SMA-CPT Francis was awarded the December Chalkboard Champion for Sarasota county and SMA-MAJ Ashley Wyka the SMA Teacher of the Year. SMA-COL Bowman stated that the breakdown of data would be presented at the next board meeting.

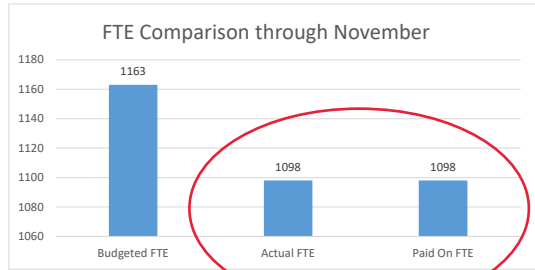

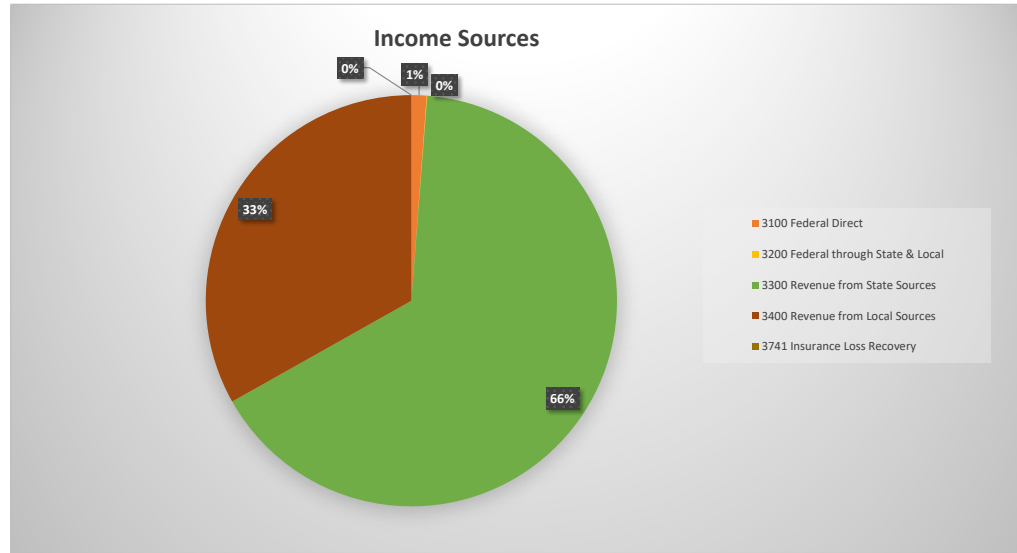

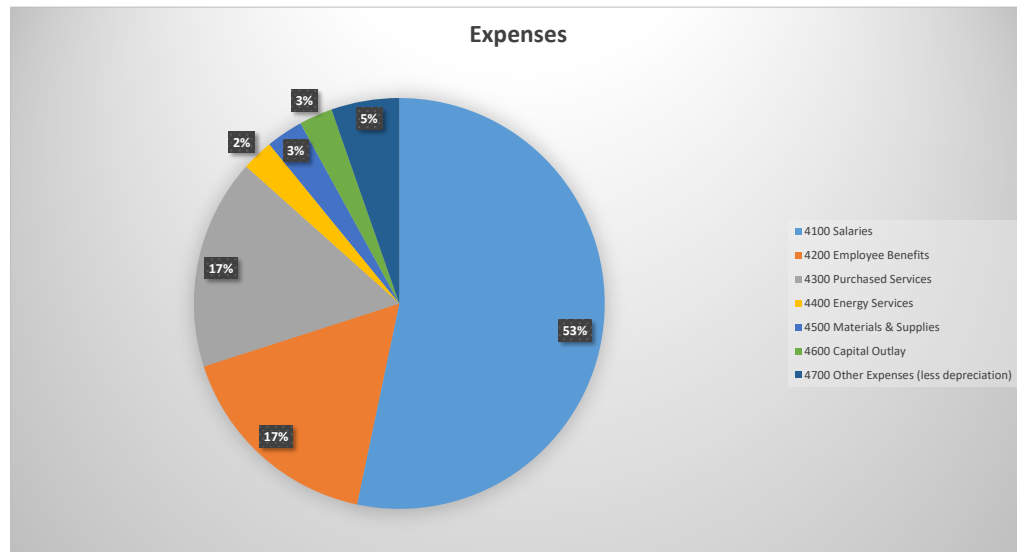
Profit and Loss Pie Charts through November 2023
