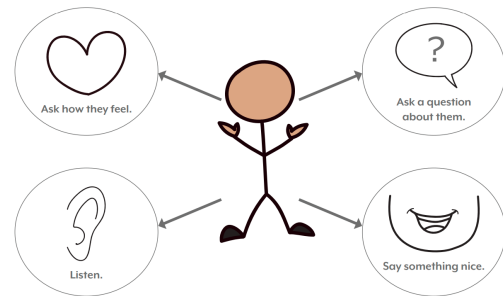

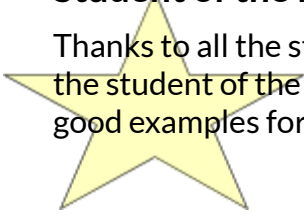
PBIS Mid-Year Booster
