PRESCHOOL SCREENING

- 1) Contact the Madison-Champaign ESC Preschool at 937-653-5214 to schedule a free developmental screening. Screenings occur periodically throughout the school year.
- 2) On screening day your child will be assessed in the following areas: Speech and Language, Motor Skills, Academic Skills, and Social Emotional Skills.
- 3) Results will be shared via mail, email or phone call.

PRESCHOOL SCREENING RESULTS

Based on your child's screening results the school district and MCCESC preschool team will determine placement for your child in our preschool program. If your child has developmental or academic concerns the team will work with you to determine if an evaluation for special education services is appropriate.



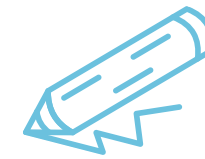

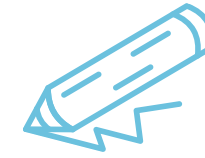
MEET THE TEACHER
