**Albin C. Wopat Memorial**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: Recipient must have earned a 3.25 GPA after seven semesters. Earned two or more athletic letters in more than one sport. Also have participated in a variety of extracurricular activities.

Requirements: All Senior High School students who plan on pursuing a career in the teaching field. Applicants must prove that they are related to a veteran or current member of the armed forces.

**Lodi Educators Association Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be a Lodi High School graduate. First preference shall be given to a member of the LEA's family, followed by candidates considering the field of education and then to all other candidates. Monies will be awarded at the end of their fall semester of freshman year indicating that a successful, full course load (minimum of 12 credits) has been completed via a transcript/grade report.

**Lodi High School Alumni Association Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be a Lodi High School graduate and plan on attending a technical school or technical program.

**Lodi High School Class of 1955 Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be planning to attend a college, university or technical school. Leadership and community service throughout their high school career is also important.

**Lodi High School Class of 1968 Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Must be a graduating senior from Lodi High School planning to attend a college, university, or vocational program.

**Lodi Rotary Club Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: Applicants must be graduates of Lodi High School and have demonstrated service to the community.

**Lodi United Methodist Church-Dolly Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: Preference will be given to students who have demonstrated community service and are planning on attending a vocational school or trade school.

**Lodi Valley Masonic Lodge Scholarship**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: Applicants for this scholarship must be Lodi High School graduates who have demonstrated leadership in both the school and community, and have been involved in service activities for the school and community.

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: Graduate of LHS who plans on pursuing advanced education in a healthcare field.

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be a Lodi High School graduate who has maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average. Selection of this recipient will be based upon the applicant's leadership and contributions to Lodi High School.

Requirements: LHS graduate planning to attend a University of Wisconsin college in science, technology, engineering or math.

Application Deadline: March 1

Requirements: The two recipients of this scholarship must be entering an Apprenticeship program, trades program, technical college or a four year college. Also, have a good work ethic and an interest in bettering themselves and their community.

**Rod & Bobbie Hanson Student Athlete Scholarship**

Sponsor: Lodi HS Golf Alumni and Family of Rod & Bobbie Hanson

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: The applicants must have earned two or more athletic letters in more than one sport. Applicants must be a LHS graduate who will be entering a college, university or technical school and who has maintained at least a 3.0 GPA after 7 semesters. Selection of these recipients will also be based on this student athlete's abilities to show leadership and be a team player.

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be enrolled as a senior at Lodi High School with the intention to graduate in 2024, and has an interest in pursuing opportunities in the areas of mental health support, advocacy, activism, or community building (e.g., involvement in groups like NAMI, the LGBTQ+ community, Big Brothers & Big Sisters, volunteering, school groups, etc.). Students are not required to be pursuing higher education, and priority will be given to students who express a financial need for their future plans. In addition the sponsor requires a short essay (200-500 words MAX) regarding how the applicant's interests and experiences align with the focus of the scholarship.

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be a Lodi High School graduate, a resident of Lodi Area School District and a senior who is graduating this calendar year. You must also be accepted or expect to enroll in higher education (vocational school, apprenticeship program). ### **Dane American Legion Auxiliary**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: A senior who is graduating this calendar year who will be attending a post secondary school, who either attends Lodi High School or is a member, or child or grandchild of a member of Dane American Legion Post 503 or Dane American Legion Auxiliary Unit 503. In addition to the local scholarship application, sponsor requires an essay on "How people in our country have benefited from the commitment of our military."

### **Duane M. & Marilyn H. Kirking**

Application deadline: March 1

Sponsor: Duane M. & Marilyn J. Kirking

Requirements: The scholarship recipient must be a graduating senior accepted at a college or university, intending to pursue a degree in a health profession with potential to become a leader in health care. In addition to a high level of academic achievement, the recipient shall have demonstrated leadership in school or other organizational and community activities. Recipient must maintain satisfactory academic standing as defined by a minimum, cumulative 2.0 GPA. In addition to local scholarship application, sponsor requires a 400 word (max) essay explaining how your experiences to date and plans for the future would make you a worthy recipient of this scholarship.

### **Harmony Grove Association**

Application deadline: March 1

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be a graduate of Lodi High School and have been accepted into a post-secondary higher education program and who has demonstrated community service. In addition to local scholarship application, sponsor requires a 200-300 word (max) essay regarding why community service is important.

### **Lake Wisconsin Lions Club Scholarships**

Application Deadline: March 1

Requirements: Two scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior. One student attending a technical college furthering their education towards an associate degree, technical diploma, trade apprenticeship, or other certification. One student attending a university/college in pursuit of a bachelor's degree. Other criteria: Volunteer service to community, character, financial need, leadership qualities, involvement in school activities and academic achievement. In addition to local scholarship application, sponsor requires a 400-500 word essay "What does community service mean to you and how have you given back to your community."

Requirements: Recipient of this scholarship must be a graduating senior of LHS and have been accepted to a post-secondary school with the intention of majoring in a medical related field. In addition to local scholarship application, sponsor requires a 500 word minimum essay "Please explain your career aspirations within the medical field, and why do you believe Lodi EMS should award you a scholarship."

### **Lodi Area Fire Department - Christopher Lord Memorial Scholarship**

Application Deadline: March 1

Requirements: You must be a resident of the Lodi Area School District and a senior who is graduating this calendar year. You must also be accepted or expect to be enrolling in higher education to study firefighting, emergency medical services, law enforcement or a related field. Please provide a minimum 500 word essay describing your career aspirations within the protective services field (fire, EMS, police), and why you believe the Lodi Area Fire Dept. should award you a scholarship.

## **Award Levels**

There are three levels of awards

- Summa Cum Laude
- Magna Cum Laude
- Cum Laude

## **Laude Score**

A student's Laude Score will be determined by multiplying 1) the student's cumulative GPA after first semester senior year by 2) the number of recognized Cum Laude Recognition courses completed in all four years.
