

Central Islip Union Free School District State Foundation Aid Plan Statement

The 2021-2022 enacted state budget includes language stating that for the 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years, each school district receiving a foundation aid increase of more than 10% or \$10,000,000 a school year must post a plan of how the funds will be used to address student performance and need.

In the 21/22 school year, Central Islip School District will hire additional Kindergarten and First Grade Teachers to decrease class size and provide personalized small group instruction with enriched content materials for all scholars. Professional staff will support students' social, emotional health and well-being, while addressing various barriers that impact their learning and achievement.

The District will implement core and supplemental programs for schools, families and community engagement. This partnership will help move students forward academically, and make the statement "Every Student Succeeds Act" our goal.
