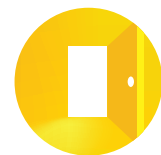

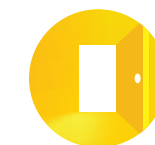

WE ARE THRILLED TO ANNOUNCE THE NEXT SEMESTER OF AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING (ASP)!

If you would like your child to participate in ASP, here are some things to know:

1. There is no additional cost to attend ASP
2. ASP is optional and is open to all students who are showing **safe and kind** behavior and can **stay with the group without 1:1 support**.
 - Participating students may attend Tuesdays and/or Thursdays
3. ASP will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school from 3:15 pm – 5:00 pm.
 - Each group will meet **1 day/week (Tuesdays or Thursdays)** for a **semester**
 - Each fall semester group will have **10 sessions**
 - **Spring Tuesdays:** February 20, 27, March 5, 12, 19, SPRING BREAK (no ASP), April 2, 9, 16, 23, 30
 - **Spring Thursdays:** February 22, 29, March 7, 14, 21, SPRING BREAK (no ASP), April 4, 11, 18, 25, May 2
4. Parents must provide transportation home at 5:00 pm
 - Rideshare will only be permitted for students ages 18+
 - Carpool or non-parent pick up will be allowed with signed consent.
5. ASP will be led by O-School staff members
6. ASP is not open to TLC students, who have their own separate activities and programs.
